
Originating in the 17th century and prominently featured in British architecture, these windows now come in state-of-the-art PVC-U versions that offer advanced functionality and improved performance.

Arch and swept windows

Gothic Arch Windows - Featuring a pointed arch at the top, these windows exude historic elegance often seen in period properties, churches, and traditional architecture. The dramatic shape makes them a perfect fit for a bold, heritage-inspired look.

Swept Head Arch Windows - With a gentle, curved arch at the top, this design creates a softer, more subtle appearance. It's an ideal choice for homeowners seeking a blend of classical beauty and understated elegance.

True Arch Windows - These feature a fully rounded arch, embodying timeless grace. Often used in Georgian or Victorian-style homes, they bring symmetry and balance to the overall design.







Tilt & Easy Clean

ECOSlide[®] PVC-U sash windows are incredibly low maintenance, requiring only a quick wipe down with a damp cloth to keep them looking as good as new.

The window sashes feature an inward opening tilt facility to allow easy and safe cleaning of the outside frame and glass from inside your home.

This is particularly useful for second storey windows, or windows positioned in hard to reach places, such as above a conservatory.

Sliding

ECOSlide[®] PVC-U sash windows primarily function like wooden box sash windows, with both the top and bottom sashes sliding up and down to suit your ventilation requirements.

Convenient and simple to operate, the two sliding sashes within an outer frame work independently of each other on a balanced load mechanism, designed to hold the sash at any height.

Colour and foil options

Timber box sash windows were always painted, and you can replicate this look with ECOSlide® elegant sashes.

If you want a more natural effect, our Crystal White, Cream, Golden Oak and Irish Oak foils give a realistic woodgrain appearance, mimicking the grained texture and appearance of an original timber window.

ECOSlide[®] is available in a range of foil options, offering variations in external and internal colour ways to suit any style or preference. Additional foil options include Chartwell Green, Anthracite Grey, Agate Grey, Rosewood, Black/Brown, Cream, Golden Oak and Irish Oak.

Alternatively, the windows can have an external finish in a colour you like, whilst maintaining a white interior to suit your home's decoration.

Spraying & Colour Matching

ECOSlide[®] PVC-U sash windows can be sprayed to match virtually any RAL colour, offering full personalisation for a truly bespoke solution tailored to your individual preferences.





Choose Your Finishing Touches

Add the finishing touches to your new ECOSlide[®] windows with traditionally-styled vertical slider hardware.

Pole eyes, tilt knobs, sash lifts, camlocks and travel restrictors are available as standard, but we can also offer D handles if needed.

All hardware is available in a number of high quality finishes.



D Handle

These optional easy-grip handles can be used in place of pole eyes or sash lifts, and can be fitted externally on the bottom of the top sash for ease of operation.



Camlocks

Locks both bottom and top sashes firmly in place when the window is fully closed. Key lockable. One sash lock is fitted to windows up to 799mm. Two are fitted on windows 800mm wide and over.



Sash Lift

Used for opening and closing the bottom sash. One sash lift is fitted to windows up to 479mm wide. Two are fitted on windows 480mm wide and over.



Travel Restrictors

Provides enhanced security and safety for your vertical sliding sash windows. Used to restrict the opening of the window to just 100mm. Key operated.




Pole Eyes

Used for opening and closing the top sash. One pole eye is fitted to windows up to 479mm wide. Two are fitted on windows 480mm wide and over.



Tilt Knobs

Allow inward tilting of the sliding sashes for easy and safe cleaning from inside the home. Two tilt knobs are fitted as standard.

Astragal Bars - External

Attention to detail

Every detail is crafted to mirror the classic look of original timber sash windows, with elegant features like run-through sash horns, astragal or Georgian bars, and both modern or traditionally styled hardware.

Sash Horns

ECOSlide[®] windows are available with and without horns, to suit your preference and building style.

Sash window horns are decorative yet functional elements found on traditional timber sash windows, primarily in older buildings. These protruding extensions, typically located at the top and bottom corners of the window frame, were originally designed to strengthen the joint between the frame and the window sash.

Today, they are often seen as a distinctive feature of Georgian, Victorian, and Edwardian windows, adding to their architectural appeal.

For Your Peace of Mind

Document Q Window

If a property was built to comply with Document Q then any replacement glazing will also need to comply.

Ground floor, basement and other easily accessible windows should be secure windows. Secure windows should be manufactured to a design that are shown by test to meet the security requirements of PAS 24: 2016. All easily accessible glazing should contain at least one pane of laminated glass.

ECOSlide[®] PVC-U sash windows are designed to be extremely safe and secure. High-performance locking systems keep your home safe from potential intruders to give you extra peace of mind.

For added safety, ECOSlide® offers the option of a 'Fire Egress' window design to provide emergency escape.

Components

- Hardex High Security Cam Lock fitted with 3 screws
- Hardex High Security Keep fitted with 5 screws
- Document Q Snap Latch fitted with metal latch
- Spacer fitted to sash

- Aluminium Support fits into frame to support snap latches
- Jam Blocks fit on top of the sash to stop movement
- Aluminium Sash Re-enforcements fitted as standard in all Document Q windows







Security Bar

ECOSlide[®] includes anti-jemmy integrated security bar, bespoke and unique to ECOSlide[®].

The bar significantly increases security, to help prevent potential intruders using tools or excessive force to try and lever open the bottom sliding sash and gain entry.

Glazing Options

As standard, each window is fitted with high-performance, toughened A+ rated double glazed units, ensuring outstanding thermal and security performance. However, for properties with special requirements, solar glass, laminate or acoustic, which has noise reduction qualities, can be specified.

We also offer a range of obscured glass options which is ideal for rooms that require privacy.
