<p>All exhibitors and contractors are required to comply with the health and safety guidelines and procedures outlined below, and to conduct work in a safe manner, not placing themselves or others at risk.</p> <p>ATTIRE DURING BUILD UP AND BREAKDOWN</p> <p>CHILDREN For safety reasons, persons under the age of 16 will not be permitted on the show floor during build up and breakdown are allowed in the vehicles within the loading bay. This policy will be strictly enforced regardless of affiliation or circumstances, and there will be no exception to this rule.</p> <p>SAFETY SHOES Always wear safety shoes when you are working. Sandals or open-toed shoes are prohibited during build up and breakdown period.</p> <p>LADDERS Do not use ladders when working at greater heights than 2.5m, but use an approved scaffold instead. Always follow the instructions and regulations when mounting a scaffold.</p> <p>SAFETY HARNESS When working at greater heights, a safety harness will protect you from falling. Especially when you are working on trusses or profiles, adequate body protection is indispensable.</p> <p>SAFETY HELMET Protect your head from falling objects and materials. Wear an approved safety helmet as soon as you enter the site. Remember a safety hat enhances your visibility to others on the site.</p> <p>REMOVE WASTE Do not let waste drag around on the stand or in front of emergency exits, but bring it to the indicated waste deposits. An orderly construction site avoids pile-ups and allows you to work efficiently and safely.</p> <p>DO NOT RIDE MANUAL PALLET TRUCKS A manual pallet truck is designed to transport goods, not people. Do not stand on pallet trucks and do not allow other people to do so.</p> <p>DO NOT STAND ON FORKLIFTS Forklifts are not suited for lifting people. Only use a forklift for the jobs it was designed for: moving goods around and getting them on and off trucks. Forklift trucks are not to be operated by any person or company other than the official lifting agent and its authorized personnel.</p> <p>USE CERTIFIED MATERIALS Always use certified materials and tools for floor covering, canvas, wiring, electricity, lighting, switchboards, drapes, paint, plastics and panels.</p> <p>DRINK AND DRUGS Those considered being under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other, in the opinion of the organisers, constitute a danger to themselves or others will be removed from the venue.</p>	<p>EMERGENCY NUMBER 1234 - using the nearby house phone +31 20 - 549 1234 - using your mobile phone</p> <p>FIRST AID There are 6 first aid rooms located in the Venue.</p> <p>INCIDENT REPORTING All exhibitors and contractors are obliged to report all injuries, serious safety incidents and building damage immediately.</p> <p>IN CASE OF A FIRE IF YOU DETECT FIRE OR SMOKE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activate the nearest fire alarm button (marked with the fire alarm signs) if possible and safe to do so • Leave the area/building in case of a fire immediately by the nearest exit (emergency exits marked with the emergency exits signs); do not use the lift. <p>IF THE FIRE ALARM IS ACTIVATED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain calm and alert, prepare to leave the building. Look for the nearest emergency exit. • Make sure that walkway and emergency exits are easy to reach. • Continue activities as normal if the fire alarm is discontinued. <p>IN CASE OF A EVACUATION ANNOUNCEMENT OR INSTRUCTION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave the building via the nearest exit (emergency exits marked with the emergency exits signs); do not use the lift. • If you encounter smoke in the stairway, use alternative exits where available. • Do not attempt to remove vehicles from parking garage or loading docks. • Follow announcements over the public address system or instruction by Amsterdam RAI staff and or fire/ police officials • Once outside the building, stay on a safe distance of the building; do not return until conditions are declared safe to do so by the Amsterdam RAI staff <p>IN CASE OF MEDICAL EMERGENCY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dial emergency number 1234 for the Security Control Room from the closest house phone or +31 20 549 1234 with your mobile phone. • Provide the security officer with your exact location • If possible with detailed information of the situation concerning injuries and the cause of any injuries • Remain calm until the first aid team and Amsterdam staff appear. <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
