




ZERO WASTE PATTERN CUTTING

"It is estimated that 15% of textiles intended for clothing ends up on the cutting room floor"

Sustainable angle





Zero waste pattern cutting can be used for a single garment or multi product lay to eliminate waste at the point of cutting the textile patterns.

Used for complete garments & trims.






1 GARMENT 3 WASTE STREAMS

> Main Fabric, Pocket Bags Facings




Could this be used alone or mixed with another component to create a padding alternative to down for puffa's?

WASTE STREAM 2 -YARNS - END OF ROLLS

Knitted into small accessories such as socks in patterns designed to accommodate waste level
