



- Character class with natural discoloration.
- Boards of very diverse colour, wood structure and varied grain.
- Permissible whiteness up to 15%.
- Sound knots to size acceptable 70 80 mm.
- Black knots and knot holes up to 30 mm are allowed.
- All knots covered with the filler.
- Permissible edge cracks up to 10 cm.


- Boards with various wood grains and structures.
- The purest class with the least possible discoloration.
- Occasional single healthy pin knots up to max 10 mm are permitted.
- Sapwood and natural cracks are unacceptable.




Basket pattern


Double herringbone

LACQUERED WOOD FLOORS

OILED WOOD FLOORS

Finish

Lacquer is meticulously layered onto the timber's surface to create a protective film, serving as a highly effective shield against general wear, water, spills, and stains.

Appearance:

Lacquered floors offer a range of sheen levels, from glossy to matte, providing a natural aesthetic. Sanded timber can achieve an exceptionally smooth, natural finish, while textured and stained surfaces can also be coated and enhanced.

Cleaning:

Regular sweeping and vacuuming with a parquet setting help eliminate abrasive dust and surface dirt. Promptly wipe up food and drink spills. Weekly or less frequent wet cleaning, using a pHneutral wood floor soap and a spray mop or well-wrung mop and bucket, is recommended.

Scratches & Repairs:

The robust lacquer coats typically prevent most scratches from reaching the bare wood, preserving durability. Minor scratches can be filled in and smoothed with a refresher or polish. For spot repairs, it's advisable to consult floor finishing professionals experienced in sanding and lacquer application.

Maintenance:

Lacquered floors can undergo sanding and resealing or complete resurfacing. Lightly sanding the existing lacquer (keying) allows for the application of new coats. If floors are fully bonded to the subfloor, a more even sanding ensures minimal surface removal, facilitating multiple resurfacing opportunities.

Finish:

The timber surface is enriched as oil is gently massaged into the wood grain, saturating it thoroughly. Once cured, the oil undergoes a hardening process, creating a natural barrier that effectively guards against general wear, water, spills, and staining.

Appearance:

Wood floors treated with oil boast a naturally matte appearance, featuring a tactile surface that can be buffed to achieve a subtle sheen. Pure oil introduces a warm, rich luster to the wood grain, and the addition of pigments offers the possibility of creating a diverse range of colours and effects.

Cleaning:

Regular sweeping and vacuuming with a parquet setting help eliminate abrasive dust and surface dirt. Swiftly address food and drink spills. Weekly or less frequent wet cleaning is recommended, using a pH-neutral oiled wood floor soap with a spray mop or a well-wrung mop and bucket.

Scratches & Repairs:

Minor scratches seamlessly blend into the grain texture, having minimal impact on the floor's durability, as the oil continues to permeate the timber surface. Damaged or repaired areas can be revitalized by buffing oil into them, seamlessly sealing and blending into the surrounding floor. Water marks, dark tannin stains, and grease spots can often be addressed with stain-removing products.

Maintenance:

To rejuvenate oiled floors, an intensive clean followed by the application of maintenance oil is recommended. While this process doesn't eliminate surface damage, it effectively renews the floor's durability and performance. Periodic oil maintenance should be carried out at regular intervals, depending on usage; for detailed advice, please visit our website.
