

Registration and Enrollment

- ⇒ We have open enrollment and registration throughout the year.
- ⇒ In order to register for our programs you must:
 - Meet the requirements (see section requirements),
 - Submit your request for registration, including your CV, credentials and proof of funding to info@eCGmn.com and/or in person.
 - Our review process takes 1 5 business days. If you accepted in our program, we will send you a confirmation email, with the schedule.

Note: We accept transfer students from other accredited schools. Existing students are welcome to transfer previous academic work to our school, as long as it is related to their program/field of study and covers the same subject as our school program/courses.

Requirements

To enroll at any of our programs, you must have:

- Minimum Associate Degree or equivalent, GPA 3.0 or above, from an accredited institution.
- 1+ years of work experience related to the field of management, preferable IT, Healthcare, Engineering, Marketing, Finance, Renewable Energy, or other industries.
- Good statistical, analytical, and math skills.
- Fluent in English (business reading and writing). Applicants who do not meet this requirement may provide sufficient evidence of competence in English by achieving a minimum TOEFL iBT score 80, with sub-scores of Reading 19, Listening 17, Speaking 20, and Writing 21 on the TOEFL iBT **OR** a minimum IELTS score of 6.5, with subsection minimums as follows: listening 6, writing 6, reading 6, speaking 6.
- Pre-approved funding. eConsulting Group, Inc. does not provide student loans.

Class Schedule

Classes run Monday through Friday, 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM. Evening sessions run from 6:00 PM - 10:00 PM. Saturday and Sunday classes are 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

The text material is included into the tuition and will be provided to the students before start of the program.

Attending the Program

In order to receive a degree students must obtain the score above 60%. The score is obtained through:

- Regular class attendance. Students are advised NOT to miss more than 10% of their class attendance.
- Class exercise (30% of their grade),
- Homework (30% of their grade),
- Final project (60% of their grade). Final project due date is the ten (10) days after completion of the course.
- Students who fail to obtain passing score will be asked to repeat the courses. Students have one (1) year from the registration date to successfully complete all courses. Those who succeed will receive the transcript and credential. Unsuccessful students will receive transcript with status "incomplete".
- Within one (1) year from the registration date, students could retake the same course, any time the course is offered and if there is an available sit. New students have priority over the retake students.
- In order to obtain credit for a course a student must attend at least 85% of the contact hours for a particular course. However, instructors are given the option of allowing a student to complete the course based on the student's documented circumstances and his or her progress in the course. An instructor may withdraw any student from the course if the student misses more than 15% of the scheduled class sessions and activities. Students must be enrolled before they can attend class.


