



ETS can provide a full range of energy related incentives and analysis, including 179D EPAct, 45L, utility rebates and refunds, energy audits, modeling and LEED certification. ETS is fully Circular 230 compliant, with over 100 years combined experience in energy modeling.

Since the inception of the Energy Policy Act of 2005, ETS has performed over ten thousand 179D EPAct and 45L reports to secure substantial benefits for property owners and public project developers. EPAct's \$1.80/square foot deduction can be applied to private property owners for retrofits or new construction projects completed between 2006 and the end of 2013. This deduction of \$1.80 per square foot can also be allocated to the designers of any public project. This allocation has

made the difference between many design firm's livelihood vs demise in recent years. 45L is a \$2,000 per unit tax credit for multi-family developers. These types of incentives are often left on the table for eligible taxpayers. On the 'demand side,' ETS has consulted on more than 110 million square feet of building space across North America. From lighting to mechanical to evaluation of potential for renewable energy such as solar and wind, ETS is an independent, third-party evaluation and implementation firm whose focus is on the client's energy savings. ETS' initial focus is on assisting clients in navigating the increasingly complex energy and tax world by delivering customized energy-management solutions for both energy procurement and energy conservation/efficiency.






