Double thickness elbows, with Kevlar high abrasion resistant material.

Internal zip skirt for joining together with trousers.

Waterproof Knee area and pockets with full length fixed knee pads (included). Zip gusset at leg bottom with Velcro strap adjuster.

Twin bands of FR yellow silver yellow and plain silver retro reflective tape.
