What is PHEM?

Pre-Hospital Emergency Medicine (PHEM) is a General Medical Council approved subspecialty for anaesthesia, emergency medicine and Intensive Care Medicine. PHEM encompasses the knowledge, technical skills and non-technical (behavioural) skills required to provide safe pre-hospital critical care and safe transfer.

PHEM Grade

Our ROAMER course is accredited as a PHEM-E training standard.

Grade	Description
E	Nationally certificated non health care professional pre-hospital provider caring for patients as a primary role eg UKSAR, some military personnel and specialist certificated police officers and firefighters.
