How To Get To ESiP

There's several options of how you might like to travel to Monyhull Church, so please have a careful read of the information below. If you've got any questions about travelling to or from the venue, please email info.esip@caauk.org.

By Road

Monyhull Church is directly south of Birmingham City Centre, situated between the A441 (west), the A435 (east) and the M42 (south). It's also easily accessible from most of the UK's main motorways - postcode is B30 3PS. There is around 80 parking spaces available at the venue, and we'll have some parking stewards ready to make sure we can fit as many cars in as possible! We don't have the capacity to reserve parking spaces unfortunately, so these will be allocated on the day on a first-come-first-served basis. Alternative parking might also be available on nearby roads, but we're just confirming that at the moment.

By Train

The nearest station to Monyhull Church is **King's Norton Railway Station**, which is approximately a 5 minute drive away. Trains to this stop run regularly from Birmingham International (next to the NEC), with a quick change at Birmingham New Street, and should have you there in 40 minutes. Please check local timetables for more up-to-date information on available services.

By Bus

Buses run to Broad Lane, which is about a few minutes' walk from Monyhull Church.
The Number 18 bus runs from King's Norton Station (Stop CB), but please check local timetables for more up-to-date information on available services.

By Air?!

Should you feel inclined, or have access to wings, Birmingham City Airport is about a 25 minute drive away from our venue! Time to dig out your passport...!
