Humberside NHS Trust

We're helping to reduce NHS waiting times by creating health hubs in remote areas. Patients visit these hubs, which are accessed in their local area, to get access to clinicians based in further afield locations for ongoing care and appointments.

Royal Bolton Hospital

Pioneering work with the Royal Bolton Hospital has seen us help them implement interactive technology in a variety of formats to improve patient rehabilitation times for those recovering from strokes.

Royal Free Hospitals NHS Trust

We delivered the technology for The Charles Wolfson Centre for Reconstructive Surgery, the first operating and teaching space of its kind which provides cutting-edge facilities for surgeons to do reconstructive procedures.
