PHL's Custody Healthcare Service



PHL was founded in 2009 by a team of experienced General Practitioners and commercial partners with a clear vision of providing services that would contribute and benefit the local healthcare community.

PHL is led by an experienced team of clinicians and healthcare leaders, with wide ranging experience in urgent and primary care environments. Our CEO, Ross Brand spent over 10 years working frontline in NHS Emergency, Acute and Urgent Care services in the UK.

We operate a wide range of services across the UK, including Custody Healthcare, ADHD Services, Wait Time Support, Virtual Wards, Integrated Urgent Care & Home Visiting, Spirometry Services and GP Practices.

PHL Pro are part of the PHL Group, providing a range of services including Specialist Support, Recruitment and Management Consultancy to the NHS and private healthcare partners.



PHL Custody Healthcare Services

PHL launched its custody healthcare service in January 2019, working as a service provider to Hampshire Police, and offering direct healthcare services to detained persons. We now operate multiple custody locations across Hampshire and London.

Our qualified healthcare professionals, including registered nurses, paramedics and forensic medical examiners, offer services in the custody suites of the assigned police force. Each local team works closely with local partner agencies, such as substance misuse, mental health, and liaison and diversion teams to offer a non-judgemental, patient-focused approach. We always consider detained person's immediate healthcare requirement, any long-term conditions and co-morbidities together with their ongoing social and health needs.

Training

PHL works with Hampshire Police to jointly deliver detention officer training. New detention officers complete a day at a satellite custody suite where they practice cell checks, booking in detainees and other daily tasks.

Our Lead Nurse is present during the shift and the detention officers are given a scenario where they find an unresponsive detainee in the cell during a routine cell check. Emergency scenarios are performed with the HCP and detention officers whilst awaiting an ambulance. This gives the detention officers a practical emergency scenario and allows them to experience what would be expected of them should this occur once they are working within their stations.




PHL are proud to be the first provider to offer medical photography in custody: during their induction, our HCP's complete training to hone their photography skills. The benefit of taking photographs to record injuries is that they provide clearer evidence for court cases. They are more accurate than line drawings and make interpretation of the injury easier.

Widening Horizons

PHL have worked in partnership with the Universities of Portsmouth, Southampton and the Open University to offer three-week placements to final year student nurses. With approximately 50% of student nurses being previously unaware that nurses and paramedics work in custody suites, these placements not only provide an excellent opportunity to observe health care being delivered outside the hospital setting, it also improves future potential recruitment opportunities for the HCP workforce by promoting this career opportunity to student nurses.
