The PHEC course is a 3-day multi-disciplinary course designed for those who are looking to broaden their experience of pre-hospital emergency care and those who may have to provide emergency care as part of their wider role (e.g. out of hours care, crowd medicine, occupational health etc.). It is aimed at health care professionals and suitably experienced others working in, or preparing to work in, pre-hospital emergency care.



The PHEC course will increase your confidence in providing emergency care in the pre-hospital environment as an immediate first responder. For those hoping to progress to a more formal role in pre-hospital immediate care (BASICS responder, PHEM trainee etc) the PHEC course combines a grounding in the principles of working in this environment with the opportunity to work alongside current practitioners from a range of backgrounds.

The PHEC course is ideally suited for HCP's working within event and mass gathering settings, it meets the requirements of the *Green Guide* for those undertaking crowd cover at UK sports stadia in the role of the Event Doctor, Nurse or Paramedic or as a member of the wider professional medical team.

The PHEC course is also open to experienced non-HCP's working within professional and voluntary advanced medical responder roles such as military medics, search and rescue personnel as well as associate practitioners and emergency care assistants.
