The physical, emotional and financial impact

PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL

We know falls are one of the most common issues facing the older person. The impact of a fall can be both mental and physical. For those unfortunate enough to suffer a fall the situation is painful, distressing and can impact on their mental health. A loss of self-confidence can make day to day tasks a challenge. In the more serious incidents where hip fractures occur a loss of mobility and independence is the immediate impact. In short the medium to long-term outlook for those suffering falls is not good and needs addressing.

FINANCIAL


The emotional and physical impact of a fall is compounded by the financial cost to care organisations and the NHS. It is estimated that over 40% of the total financial cost of falls among the elderly in the UK is attributed to hip fractures totalling £2 billion.

Bristol University identified the cost to the NHS of a single hip fracture to be £13,000 in the first 12 months. While this is a significant number, the hidden costs not accounted for include the cost of empty care home beds, the additional equipment, and staffing required by the faller once they leave hospital.

Up to 20% of those falling enter long-term care within the first year...



...tragically up to 25% of those over the age of 80 will die in the year following their fall.



30% of those over 65 suffer a fall per year...



... almost 50% of those over the age of 80 experience the same.

Reducing the impact and getting up again

When someone falls and it is confirmed that no significant injury or fracture has resulted, the next step is to get the person back to a safe seated or standing position calmly and in a manner that is safe for both the person falling and the OT or care professional attending them.

RAIZER[®] M

This is a manual crank operated lifting chair, no physical lifting is required and the crank operation requires minimal effort.

The M is primarily designed to be budget friendly and for domestic use helping fallers to get back on their feet be it in care or their own home. Fallers are lifted to their feet with minimal fuss and without the need to call an ambulance. Comes complete with carry case and headrest.






