Designed to assess occupational competence in the workplace. Learners are required to demonstrate their skills, knowledge and experience laying modular paving.

On average it may take between 10-12 months to complete this qualification. You will undertake the NVO at your site and be assessed remotely or at site if needed.

Your assessor will also maintain regular contact by phone, text message and email. Your assessor will provide support throughout the assessment process to ensure timely completion of your NVQ.

Once completed you will be awarded a certificate to demonstrate competence to the national standard.
