








Touch lid bins available for the Method Sixty





Lock your Method Sixty recycling stations into place, side-by-side, backto-back or to a wall. Particularly useful in large facilities and high traffic areas.


Available in 2 or 3 bin connectors or use an expansion kit for larger stations.

Connectors are currently available only for the 60L bins.







