

Case Study: Ribblesdale High School

THE PROJECT


A new access control system for a high school in the heart of the Ribble Valley.

THE CHALLENGE

To replace the ageing existing system with as little interruption to school life as possible, while designing a reliable solution to meet all the school's access control requirements.

THE SOLUTION

A comprehensive ATRIUM access control system securing more than 30 doors, utilising magnetic locking and card control.

HOW IT WORKS

ATRIUM A22 controllers are installed across the school to create a cohesive network.

Users are issued with access cards which they must hold up to the reader to release the lock and gain access.

The access control and locking solution works in conjunction with the school's fire alarm system to ensure safe evacuation and lockdown.

Sleek black STAR-PB readers are installed at each door, with electro-magnetic locks securing the doors.

Time schedules are set up using the intuitive ATRIUM software, timing the operation of the access control system with the timing of classes throughout the day.
