# The industry standard >

We've been producing Codes of Practice for over 45 years, providing good engineering and safety practice for the LPG industry.

We work closely with guidelines set out by the Government to create our Codes of Practice and we make sure they are continually updated to follow the very latest legislation. Often we work with Government stakeholders to ensure the codes follow the necessary parameters, while also ensuring they are fit for purpose and suitable for our industry.

## What are they?

In its basic form a Code of Practice is a written guideline set out by a professional association. They guide members and stakeholders towards compliance with regulatory policy while also being fit for purpose and suitable for the industry they are aimed at.

Our Codes of Practice have been developed for a wide variety of sectors including street food and commercial catering, the caravan and motorhome industry, fuel stations and the design and operation of LPG road tankers.

We have 29 Codes of Practice available which are free to members. They can be purchased individually or in multiples with a Gold Licence which also enables you to print off or upload to a company shared drive or intranet.

## Why use the Codes of Practice?

Using our Codes and adhering to the principles will not only provide the practical guidance needed, but they will assist you in adopting good engineering and safety practice.

Although Codes of Practice are not an authoritative interpretation of the law, following the guidance in the Codes will mean you are generally doing enough to comply with the relevant regulations. Similarly, Health and Safety Inspectors seeking to secure compliance with the law may refer to the guidance as illustrating good practice.



Codes of Practice can create a foundation for strong implementation of safe working practices, and lead industry to take a consistent approach to design, installation, distribution, inspection and testing.
