We are a charitable organisation that provide simulated casualties for training.

We work hard to create the illusion of illness from a faint to a heart attack and injury from a splinter to a protruding broken bone with special effects makeup. We study how the victim would behave, acting with appropriate posture, facial expression and speech. We respond to our treatment by providing vital feedback during the scenarios or role-play and in any debrief session afterwards.

All our members are volunteers, giving their spare time to training and practising our 'art' and administering the organisation. Many of us are first aiders, and some are medical professionals and SFX makeup experts.

We have the conviction that rescue, first aid, and medical training

are improved by having casualties and patients who look and behave as realistically as possible.



Casualties Union evolved from the Surrey County Civil Defence Rescue School, set up

during WWII by Eric Claxton to train in bringing bomb victims out of damaged buildings. He set up a course in which acting, made-up casualties were used to teach skills to rescuers. Casualties Union evolved from this school in 1942, and we are still going strong many decades later!











Interested in using us?

The organisations we work with are usually astonished at the effect on staff or students when they meet our 'casualties' in action. The realism of the makeup and acting is the nearest thing they will get to the real emergency. Many tell us they suddenly forgot it was simulated and had the adrenalin rush that the actual situation creates.

Our members provide feedback during the incident by responding appropriately to careful or clumsy handling. This is good training, for they learn to manage it productively.

In a debrief sessions, we offer invaluable tips on how performance could be improved.

Members are covered by Public Liability and Personal Accident insurance and are fully briefed before any exercise. We take the safety of our members and participants very seriously.


