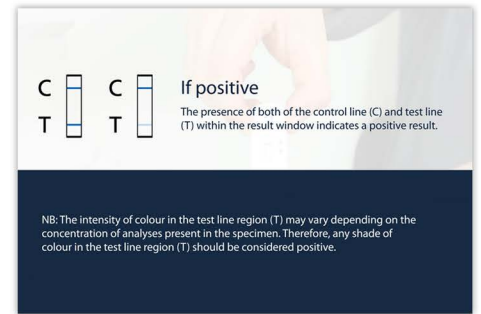
Medical training

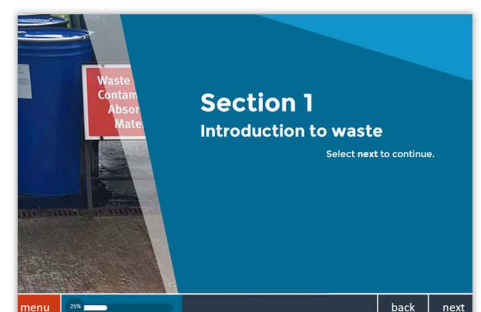
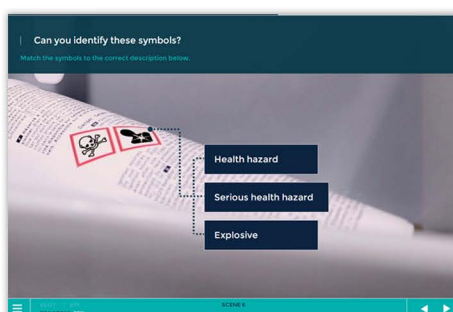
IPC and Covid

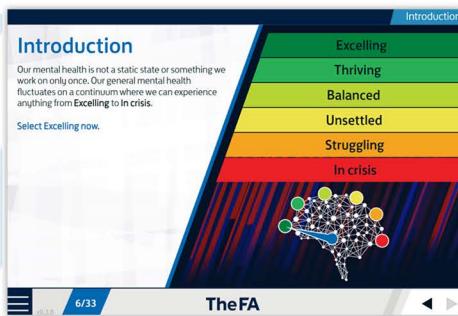
Waste management

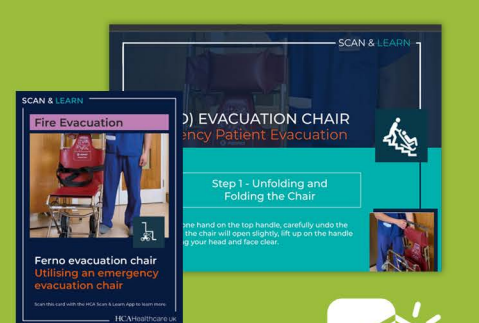


Vehicle layout
