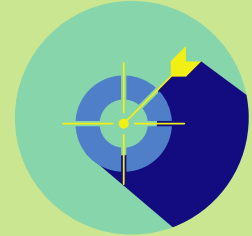


oneworld's commitment to environmental sustainability

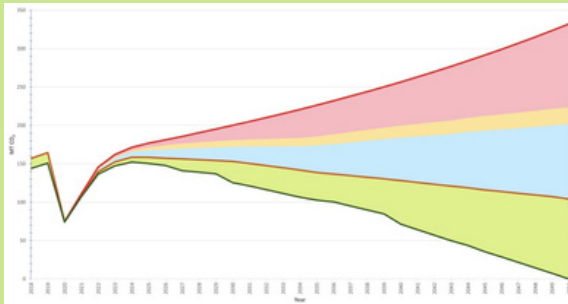
10% sustainable aviation fuel use by 2030

Sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) is a cleaner substitute for conventional jet fuel as it produces significantly lower carbon emissions. **oneworld** and its member airlines have committed to reach a target of 10% sustainable aviation fuel use across the alliance by 2030. This is not just about setting a target, but also committing to playing an active role in the development of SAF at commercial scale that is affordable, available and certified with the sustainability criteria as recognised by ICAO and relevant authorities.



Pathway to carbon neutrality

Enabling corporate customer reporting

We are committed to supporting our corporate travel clients in their journey to becoming more sustainable. In 2022, **oneworld** launched an emissions reporting tool for its corporate travel clients, enabling them to deliver on their sustainability objectives. Going forward, we are committed to partnering corporate clients on innovative approaches to further advance sustainability in travel.



Advancing sustainable aviation fuel

oneworld member airlines are working together to advance the production of sustainable aviation fuel (SAF), including through industry-leading joint commitments to purchase SAF. In the first initiatives for a global airline alliance, **oneworld** members announced commitments to purchase up to 1.35 billion gallons of SAF at California airports. Joint commitments like these are crucial to signal demand for SAF - and incentivise the investment needed to further mature production capacity. **oneworld** is supportive of calls to align certification of SAF so we may partner our corporate customers to further drive uptake.
