On a train journey from London King's Cross to Edinburgh, 22.77kg CO2 emissions are released in comparison to the same journey on a plane which releases 145.07kg CO2 emissions.

On average, a plane produces over 53 pounds of carbon dioxide (CO2) per mile. If you take the train, then you'll cut carbon dioxide by half.

CO2 EMISSIONS



The calculations are based on:

- Car = average petrol car 0.35915 kgCO2e/mile / 1.5 (averahe loading for a car DfT statistic dateset vehicle mileage and occupancy) = 0.2394333333 kgCO2e/ pass mile
- Train = National Rail 0.0689119388 kgCO2e/ pass mile
- Plane = Domestic Flight with radiative forcing 0.4389957652 kgCO2e/ pass mile


