

ENHANCED SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR TEAMS '21

Northstar Meetings Group has been producing in-person events in support of the travel industry as safely and as responsibly as possible since April of this year. Because so many TEAMS attendees interact closely with athletes at the youth, collegiate, Olympic and professional levels, we are enhancing our health and safety protocols for TEAMS '21 to an even higher standard with the goal of safeguarding everyone's well-being. As of September 9, 2021, the following enhanced health and safety protocols for TEAMS '21 are in effect.


SCREENING:

All TEAMS '21 attendees must take a COVID-19 test in the 72 hours prior to their arrival in Atlantic City, regardless of vaccination status. Both PCR and Rapid Antigen tests are acceptable, but test results must be reported by a third-party (self-reported testing results will not be accepted). There are thousands of testing locations nationwide, including at major drugstore chains such as Walgreens and CVS. If you have trouble locating a convenient testing location, your local or county health department or Testfortravel.com are other resources for finding testing locations that can provide your results in the 72-hour-or-less window.



REPORTING:

Attendees will be provided with a link to SafeAccess, the secure portal you will use to report your test results to us after you receive them from your testing location.



MASKS & PHYSICAL DISTANCING:

While on-site at TEAMS '21, attendees will be required to wear face masks and maintain social distancing while indoors, regardless of vaccination status. Masks may be lowered or removed while you are eating, drinking or on stage. While attending outdoor functions, it is recommended that attendees wear face masks (except while eating and drinking) and maintain social distancing.



ENHANCED CLEANING:

All venues and sites where participants will gather will undergo enhanced, deep cleaning before, during and after our events.



PERSONAL HYGIENE:

Hand-washing facilities and hand-sanitizing stations will be provided at all hotels and venues.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Northstar has reviewed the air filtration provided by the meeting venues' heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems.



REGISTRATION:

Northstar will employ a system that facilitates limited-contact badge distribution for all attendees.



PHYSICAL CONTACT:

Handshakes, embraces and other close physical contact are discouraged.



FOOD & BEVERAGE:

Northstar works closely with venue partners to employ the highest standards of safety in preparing and serving food and beverages.



SELF-CHECK:

Attendees who become symptomatic (fever, loss of sense of taste or smell, nausea, etc.) at any time immediately prior to or during a Northstar event should not participate in the event and should seek appropriate medical attention.
