The central mainline station in Bristol is Bristol Temple Meads which is 0.5 miles to our base hotel and welcome point.

Bristol Airport offers over 110 direct flights from major European cities and worldwide connections via international hubs. The airport is a 25-minute drive to Bristol City Centre.

Home to Banksy's world-class street art, Aardman Animations and designated UNESCO City of Film in 2017, Bristol is renowned for its vibrant arts and culture scene. The city buzzes all year round from an outstanding annual programme of events in an eclectic mix of venues and outdoor spaces, including Upfest - Europe's largest street art festival and the spectacular Bristol International Balloon Fiesta.

With iconic sights including Brunel's Clifton Suspension Bridge and the historic SS Great Britain on the harbourside and Aerospace Bristol housing the last Concorde to fly, Bristol's reputation for pioneering engineering and innovation is as relevant today as it has always been.

- The only UK destination to be listed in Lonely Planet's 'Best in Travel 2026' for its street art scene.
- Designated as a UNESCO Creative City of Film in 2017 - often dubbed as 'Green Hollywood' Bristol plays a prominent role in producing nature programming, with 35% of global production created here including Blue Planet and Tiny World.
- One of two UK cities in the UK awarded Gold Sustainable Food City status.
- Voted 'World's Best Culinary Destination' in the 2019 Food Trekking Awards.
- The only UK city to win the European Green Capital award achieved in 2015 and the UK's greenest city in 2019.
- The UK's first Cycling City.
- Home to the UK's most powerful supercomputer, Isambard AI.

- Dinner and behind the scenes tour of Bristol Beacon, Bristol's largest venue in the city centre that has recently undergone a 5 year long refurbishment.
