## Chantilly Castle

*The castle as we know it today was bequeathed by Henri d'Orléans, duke of Aumale, penultimate son of the French king Louis-Philippe I. After the French Revolution, the castle was destroyed and its domain reduced to a poor piece of land. The Duc d'Aumale devoted his life to rehabilitating the site, restoring it and adorning it with unique, rare and precious works of art by the hands of great masters such as Rafael. Today, as a museum, a park, a witness to history and an exceptional venue for your events, the Château de Chantilly is a proud part of France's historical heritage.*
