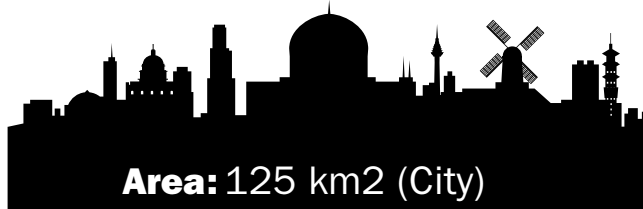

## UNIQUE HISTORICAL SITES

- Within Jerusalem's Old City walls lie some of the region's most significant historic sites. As one of the most ancient cities in the world, archeologists have uncovered artifacts from the Canaanite, Babylonian, Persian, Greek, Roman, Christian and Muslim eras. The scenic overlook on the Mount of Olives takes in the entire Old City and its Jewish, Armenian, Christian and Muslim Quarters as well as other significant historic landmarks.
- The Western Wall (Kotel) which is the last remaining outer wall surrounding the Second Temple destroyed by the Romans King Herod in 70 CE is located at the foot of the mountain.
- The Western Wall tunnels, next to the Wall, enable visitors to go below the wall for a sense of ancient Jerusalem, an excavation site well worth visiting.
- The ancient Roman Cardo ruins and renovated Hurva synagogue are both a five-minute walk from the Western Wall. Another ten minutes of walking will bring you to the Jaffa Gate and the Tower of David Museum. Christian tradition holds Jerusalem as the place where Jesus was crucified and resurrected. From the Mount of Olives continue to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations, the site where Mary Magdalene is said to have been buried according to the Eastern Orthodox Church.
- Continue around the Old City to visit the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and the Garden Tomb.
- Ein Kerem is a pastoral village neighboring Jerusalem where the Church of St. John the Baptist is located. Bethlehem and the Church of Nativity are a short drive from the capital.
- After Mecca and Medina, Jerusalem is home to the third holiest site for Sunni Muslims, the Al Aqsa Mosque. Adjacent to Al Aqsa is the Dome of the Rock, which according to tradition, was visited by Muhammad during his Night Journey. Prior to your visit, make sure to check visiting hours.

Jerusalem is a rising star in the innovation and technology sectors, hosting various annual business conferences, initiatives and symposiums, regularly attracting international advisors, top executives and investors from all over the world. With this continual crop of events, more and more companies and businesspeople are taking note of what the city has to offer, in terms of industry and more.

**Israel was dubbed The Startup Nation after achieving the greatest number of per-capita startups and venture capital investments in the world.**

In March 2017, Mobileye was acquired by Intel for \$15 billion. A company that started as an idea in the halls of Jerusalem’s Hebrew University harnessed the city’s knowledge, passion and resources to become the largest acquisition in Israel. Conference delegates can visit major R&D centers and innovation hubs and benefit from access to Hebrew University and the Hadassah Medical Center, two global groundbreakers in medical and scientific research. Jerusalem is known for its welcoming sense of community – an asset that has greatly contributed to its status as an innovation hub for industries ranging from the life sciences and medical technologies to hi-tech.

**Jerusalem has also rated as one of the top ten best places to work in academia outside the US.**

The Hebrew University is behind multiple initiatives to broaden scientific horizons. The University partnered with Stanford University and Hadassah Medical Center to create BioDesign, a multi-disciplinary approach to medical innovation that is behind groundbreaking medical devices that have been used all over the world.

Jerusalem boasts a multitude of Nobel laureates hailing from the Hebrew University.

**Both the University and Hadassah Medical Center have received worldwide praise for revolutionary innovations and R&D.**

Together with the Economy Ministry, Jerusalem works hard to promote all sectors of society into the hi-tech scene, in particular those of lower socioeconomic status in the Arab and ultra-Orthodox communities.

Together with American hi-tech company AxiomSL and the Economy Ministry, a center in the Malha Technology Park in Jerusalem was built aimed at training and assisting ultra-Orthodox workers to integrate into the hi-tech industry. Other global tech and pharmaceutical giants that have a strong presence in Jerusalem include IBM, Cisco, Intel, RAD, Teva and Johnson & Johnson. Alongside these are a host of startups, many of whom are beating industry giants at their own game.

**Jerusalem in recent years has evolved and is**

**becoming a magnet for entrepreneurial activity and cutting-edge innovation.**

In just the past five years alone, the city has transformed itself into an exciting, globally-recognized innovation hub.

# EPICENTER OF KNOWLEDGE

What do Albert Einstein, former Indian President Pranab Mukherjee and Oscar-winning actress Natalie Portman have in common? The answer is the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Einstein the father of physics was also one of the university's founding fathers – along with Martin Buber and Sigmund Freud – and more recently, in 2015, the university also awarded the former Indian President Mukherjee with an honoree doctorate degree. 2015 was also the year that the Center for World University Rankings listed the Hebrew University

as the 23rd best university in the world, beating all European universities except Oxbridge. And it's not for nothing. With eight Nobel Laureates, 9,325 patents covering 2,600 inventions registered by the university's R&D program, Yissum, Hebrew University is at the forefront of the world's academic and scientific communities. The scope of human endeavors being undertaken in any of the university's 4,000 research programs is breathtaking: From exploring radioactive supernova explosions to producing effective drug therapies for degenerative diseases like Alzheimer's to pushing the envelope in the medical marijuana or "cannatech" field to game changing inventions across the board – everything from cherry tomatoes to automotive collision prevention systems like

Mobileye – Jerusalem is the birthplace of it all. Israel's capital also boasts seventeen other academic institutions; including three schools for film and theater, the world-famous Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design and the Jerusalem Academy of Music and Dance. The city's academic heritage stretches back more than two millennia when King Solomon, "the wisest of all men," built the Temple in the Holy City. It's no wonder then that the world's holiest city is also the epicenter of knowledge.



# THE JERUSALEM FACTOR

Jerusalem's stones pulsate with the creative energy generated by the residents of this unique city. Scientists, entrepreneurs and business leaders; clergy and pilgrims of all faiths; artists, musicians, actors and dancers raised here and from all over the world flock to the Holy City to immerse themselves in the city's mesmerizing spirit and magnetic dynamism. Jerusalem brims with cultural events for all ages, tastes and budgets; from city walks and lectures, to theater, groundbreaking art and design exhibitions, international and local festivals as well as musical performances and sports events.

With its rich history, cultural diversity and timeless beauty, it is no wonder that Jerusalem enjoyed record-breaking tourism numbers last year. But there's another feature besides the familiar sightseeing attractions that draws over four million tourists to the world's holiest city every year – the fun factor.

From the experiential to the interactive, events in Jerusalem are hardly ever just an observational affair. Even classical music concerts often include audience participation.

The confluence of ethnicities that merge together in Jerusalem create a unique culinary tapestry, a weaving of ancient and modern tastes and techniques from East and West. Whether searching for creamy hummus or the freshest fish in the city's open marketplaces, good food is a central tenet of life for all Jerusalemites. Restaurants and cafes abound on the street and on rooftops.

There are convenient eateries offering ethnic and street food staples like 'Meorav Yerushalmi' - Jerusalem Mixed Grill (a dish so identified with the city that it is named after it) to upscale, Michelin-rated chef restaurants. As is the case with just

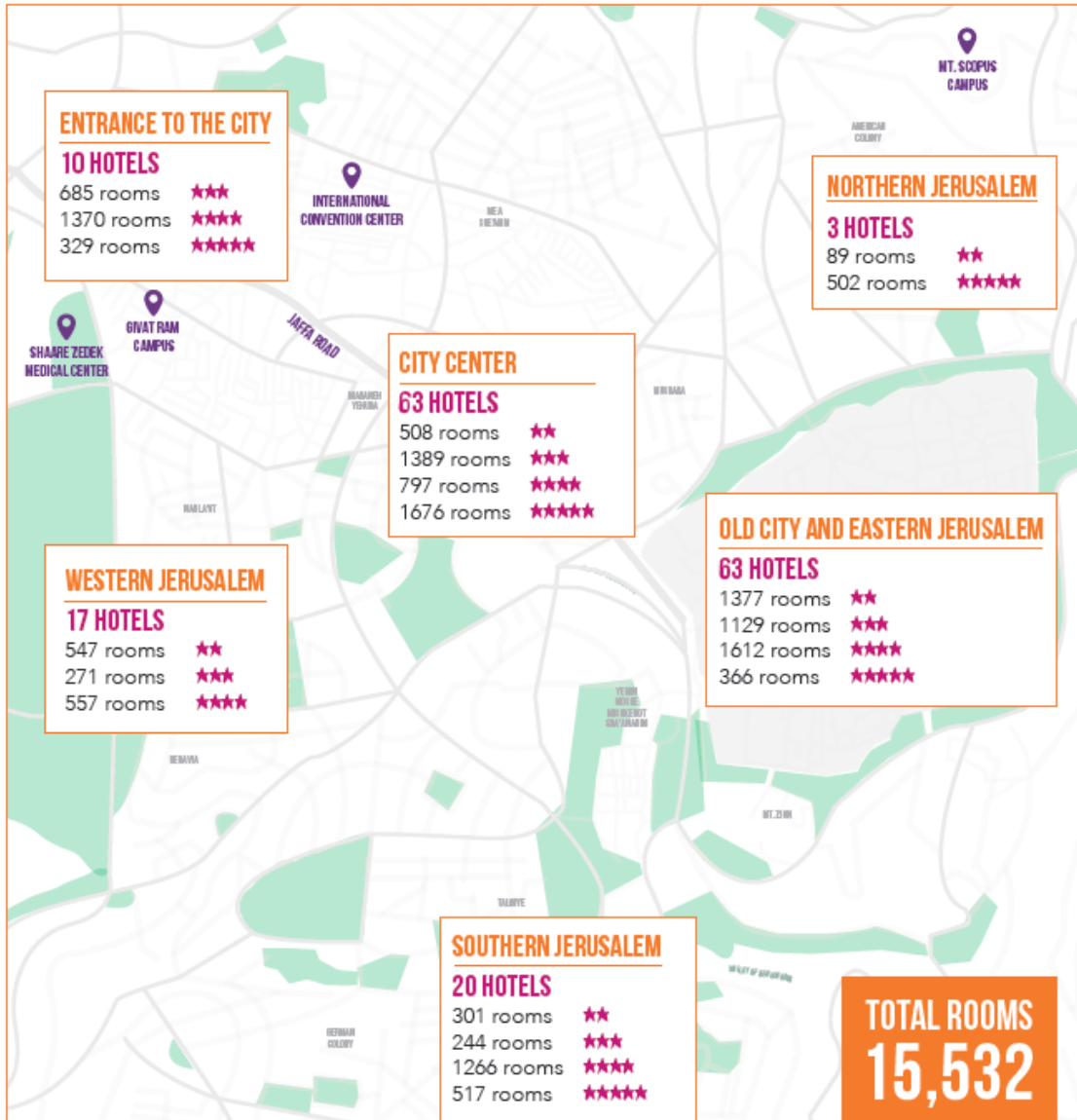

# TRANSPORTATION

## Ben Gurion Airport

Ben Gurion International, Israel's main airport, is located midway between Jerusalem and Tel Aviv – 20 minutes to Jerusalem by train. The airport is a short four-hour flight to and from most European capitals – with direct flights to the following 141 locations (42 of those destinations have daily direct flights). Visitors from most countries do not require a visa to enter Israel and passports are not stamped upon arrival or departure. The Israel Foreign Ministry has a list of those countries from which tourists are required to present a prearranged visa. Personal visas can be issued upon request for delegates from countries without diplomatic relations with Israel. It is recommended to present a list of all conference participants in advance to the airport authorities in order to save time upon arrival.

## From Ben Gurion Airport to Jerusalem Intercity Train

An express train from Ben Gurion Airport to Jerusalem in under 20 minutes with the cost of €6. The final stop is at the Yitzhak Navon railway station, just in front of the ICC (Jerusalem International convention Center).

## Private Taxi

Taxis with permits from the Israel Airports Authority are situated at the exit of the Terminal 3 Arrivals Hall. Taxis to Jerusalem should cost around 55 EUR during the week and about 70 EUR on Saturdays. There is no need to book ahead unless you are

travelling from Jerusalem to the airport.

**Shared Taxi (Nesher Sherut):** A cheaper, popular alternative is the shared taxi or shuttle, known locally as a sherut. The multi-seated van departs from outside the Arrivals Hall and transports passengers to their Jerusalem destinations. Just note that most drivers will wait for the shuttle to fill up before leaving. The service operates 24/7 and there's no need to pre-book if you're travelling from the airport. For travel from Jerusalem to the airport, you need to book 24 hours in advance and provide your flight time. The shared taxi costs about 15 EUR.

## Bus

The Afikim bus company operates a service between Jerusalem and Ben Gurion Airport. Bus line 485 operates on the hour 24 hours a day, picking up passengers at a terminal in front of the Knesset (Israel's Parliament) and outside the Central Bus Station. The fare for the one-hour journey is around 4 EURO.

## Transportation in the Capital

There are many places to rent cars in Jerusalem. Note that the entrance to Jerusalem and certain areas in the center of the city have heavy traffic during the morning and late afternoon rush hours.

## Taxi

Taxis in Jerusalem are ubiquitous and should cost no more than around 10 EUR for a ride within the city limits. A private taxi fare to the airport ranges from around 45 EUR



to slightly more with luggage. You may ask for a receipt at the end of the journey. Please note that there is a surcharge of 1 EUR when ordering taxis by phone. Taxi ordering applications such as GetTaxi operate in the city. Walking is the best way to experience the city and its beauty. Walking around downtown is easy and getting to the Old City from the center on foot should take no more than 20 minutes. Visiting other cities from Jerusalem: Getting around Israel is fairly simple and you can easily organize a day trip to another city. Tel Aviv is a 45-minute bus ride away and well worth a visit. Nazareth is about a two-hour trip while the Dead Sea can be reached in less than 40 minutes by car and just over an hour by bus.

## Light Rail / Bus

Jerusalem has a convenient network of buses and a light rail system that connects one end of the city to the other. The light rail single fare ticket costs 2 EUR or a 10-ride ticket for 12 EUR (only available with a smart ride card known as a Rav Kav). Tickets must be purchased at the light rail stops prior to your journey and cannot be purchased on the trams themselves. Trams arrive every 7 minutes at peak times and 15 minutes off-peak.

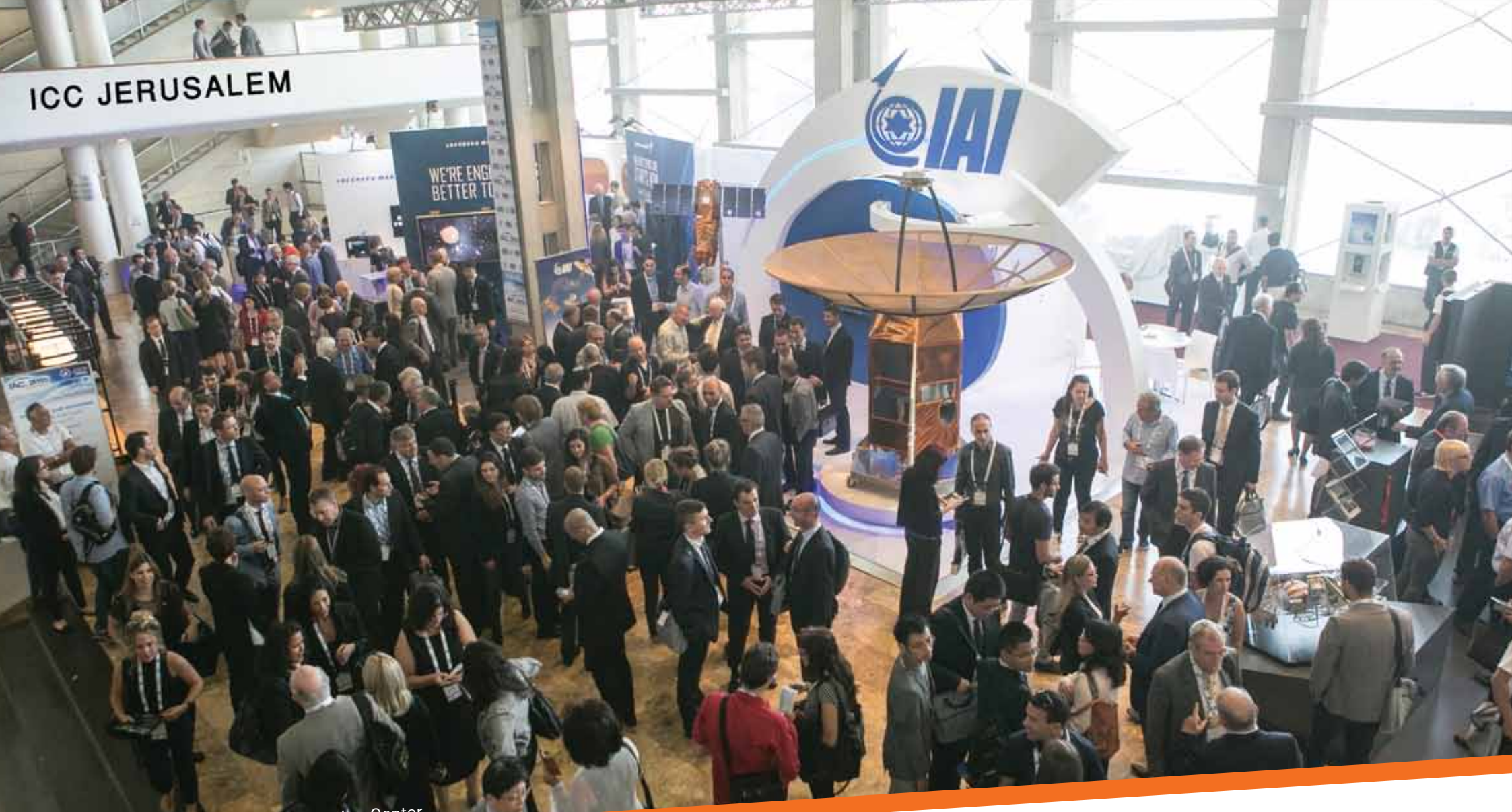

### **Kidron Valley**

The Kidron Valley is one of Jerusalem's most sacred sites, housing some of the earliest Jewish tombs in history. All three major monotheistic religions view the Kidron Valley as a central location in the "end times" prophecy, hence the cemeteries throughout the valley.

## CHRISTIAN QUARTER

The Christian Quarter abounds with churches and chapels of different denominations, and its narrow alleyways are constantly replete with pilgrims, monks and nuns. To tour the quarter enter through the Lion's Gate and follow the Via Dolorosa, which includes the 14 stations through which Jesus is believed to have passed while carrying the cross.

The awe-inspiring building standing today dates back to the 12th century.

## JEWISH QUARTER

In the time of Herod, the area of the modern-day Jewish Quarter was part of a luxurious "upper city," occupied primarily by the families of important Jewish Temple priests. Today some

3,500 people reside in the quarter (also known as "HaRova") which is a short walk from the Western Wall and many synagogues and points of interest.

### Western Wall

Marking the remains of the external retaining wall of the Second Temple, destroyed in 70 CE, this site is considered the most sacred in Judaism and is the most visited site in Jerusalem. The Western Wall serves as a site of veneration for Jews and draws crowds of visitors of all religions and everyone is invited to place a note within its cracks.

### The Temple Institute

A visit to the New Temple Institute Visitors center is like a visit to the Holy Temple itself. After almost 2000 years, you can view replicas of the holy vessels and ritual garments that were used in the Temple. Original oil paintings depict the history of the Holy Temple and recreate the story of daily life enabling visitors to experience as never before the atmosphere of the Temple era.

This striking edifice is built over a rock that is believed by Muslims to be the place where Mohammed rose to heaven. Situated next to Al Aqsa Mosque, the shrine is the oldest Islamic monument standing today. Only Muslims are allowed inside.

### Al Aqsa Mosque

Al Aqsa is one of the most sacred locations for Muslims. The mosque itself can accommodate about 5,000 worshippers. Non-Muslims are not allowed to enter the mosque.

## MUSLIM QUARTER

This is the largest and most vibrant of the quarters. In the quarter, find a colorful and bustling market, which is a favorite among visitors to the city.

### Ecce Homo Convent

The convent was built in 1857 and its basement holds a famous slab of stone pavement, etched with games played by the Romans. The convent also includes the Ecce Homo Church, which contains part of the Ecce Homo Arch.

### The Souq (Market)

With a distinctive Arabian nights feel to it, this market's seemingly endless alleyways are lined with shops selling everything from jewelry and clothes to hookahs and ceramics.

## ARMENIAN QUARTER

Situated between Jaffa Gate and Zion Gate in the southwestern section of the Old City, this quarter is the smallest, and is primarily a residential area for about 1,000 Armenians.

### St. James Cathedral

The jewel of the Armenian Patriarchate of Jerusalem and the spiritual center of this quarter. Dating back to the 12th century, the cathedral was built on the site of the tombs of St. James the Apostle and St. James the brother of the Lord. The mid-afternoon vesper service that takes place at 15:00 is often accompanied by the world-famous Armenian Patriarchate Choir.

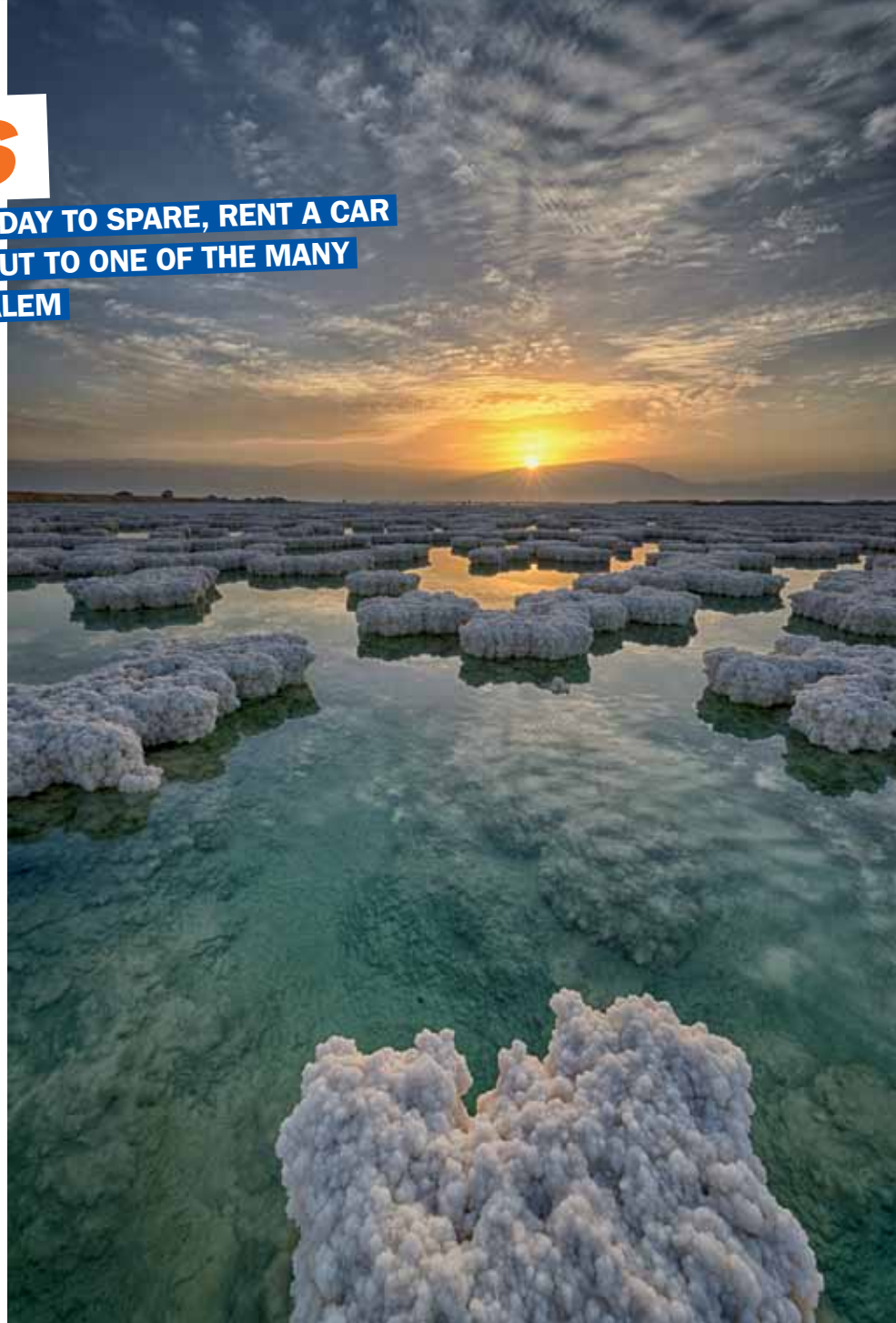
### Soreq Winery

## THE DEAD SEA

About a 40-minute drive from Jerusalem lies one of the world's most natural wonders – the Dead Sea. Flanked by the Judean Desert to the west and the Mohab Mountains to the east. The unique concentration of



salt in the Dead Sea waters has long been known to have medicinal value, causing people to travel from all over the world to slather themselves in its nutrient-rich mud. Legend says it was the Queen of Sheba who first believed in the mystical healing powers of the water, then Cleopatra traveled from Egypt to build the world's first spa there. Most of the hotels are located in the Ein Boqueq area, which offers crowded but user-friendly beaches and a nearby center that is good for lunch.

### Ein Gedi

West of the Dead Sea, Ein Gedi is an oasis rich in flora and fauna. The Ein Gedi national park and reserve is one of the most important reserves in Israel and a sanctuary for many plant and animal species. The park includes two streams and waterfalls marked by hiking trails.

## MASADA

Masada is a rugged natural fortress overlooking the Dead Sea. A place of majestic beauty, Masada's story is as action-packed and tragic as any Hollywood blockbuster. You can ascend the mountain by a centuries-old path or take the cable car to the top.
