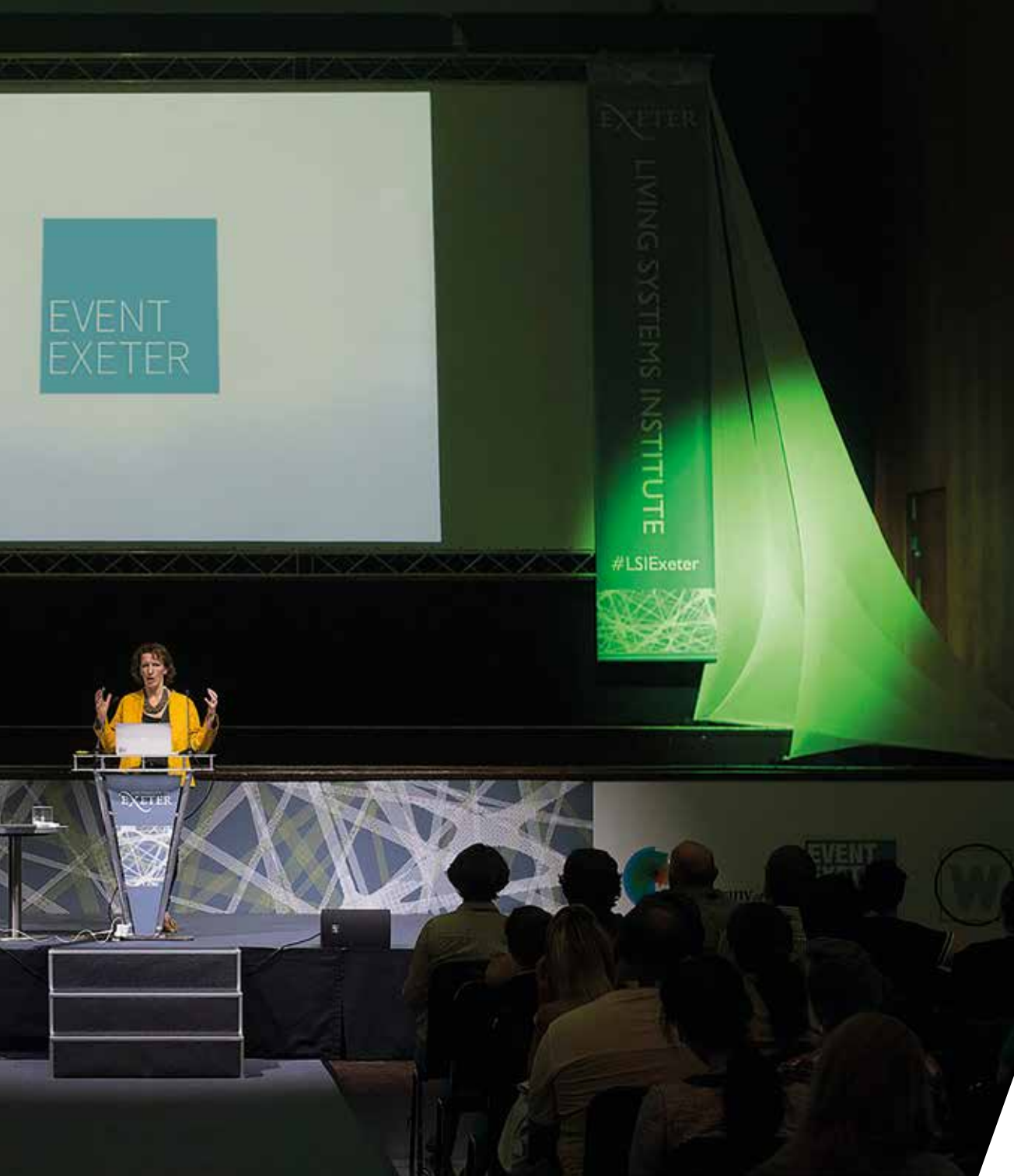

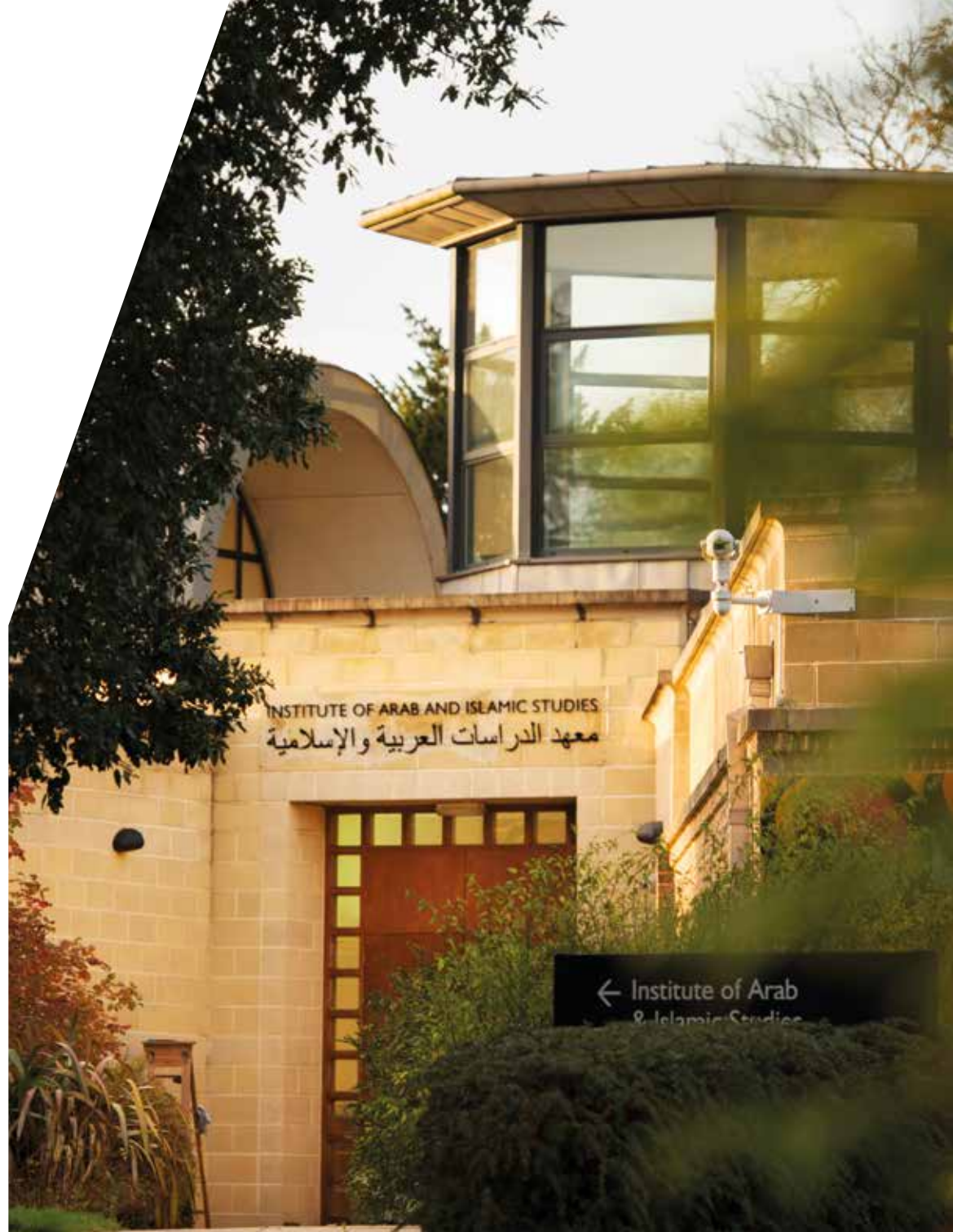

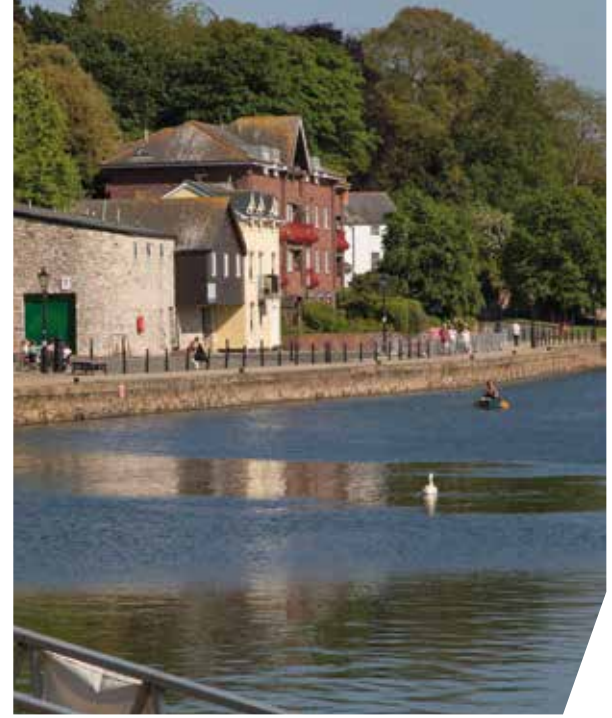
THE CITY OF EXETER
