

ENHANCED SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR LIVE EVENTS

The highest standards of safety and hygiene will be applied to Northstar Meetings Group events, both in the planning of the event, and its production and management onsite.



Enhanced Cleaning:

All venues and sites where participants will gather will undergo enhanced, deep cleaning before, during and after our events.



Food & Beverage:

Northstar will work closely with venue partners to employ the highest standard of food safety.




Personal Hygiene:

Hand washing facilities and hand sanitizing stations will be provided at all hotels and venues.



PreCheck:

Attendance by participants who become symptomatic (fever, loss of sense of taste or smell, nausea, etc.) at any time prior to traveling or during Northstar events is not permitted.



Environmental Considerations:

With venue partners, Northstar will review the air filtration provided by the meeting venues' heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems.




Screening:

Northstar requires that all attendees receive a negative PCR or Rapid Antigen test to be taken within 72 hours prior to their flight or proof of vaccination in order to attend. Once the attendee has received such documentation, please share it with the designated Northstar representative for the event.



Registration:

Northstar will employ a system that facilitates limited contact badge distribution for all participants.



Physical Distancing:

All events will follow local physical distancing guidelines and provide additional physically distanced seating, when space allows, for guests.



Masks:

Masks are recommended for all participants. Non-vaccinated participants will be asked to wear a face mask during all event functions. Additionally we will follow local health & safety protocols regarding masks.



Physical Contact:

Handshakes and embraces are not recommended when there is a high infection rate.



Medical Support:

Northstar will provide temperature taking devices for any attendee that wishes to monitor their temperature, as well as a private area for those that are not able to quarantine in their guest rooms until they can obtain medical assistance.
