

ECONOMY	Since independence in 1968, Mauritius has developed from a low-income, agricultural-based economy to a middle-income diversified economy with growing industrial, financial, and tourism sectors. For most of this period, annual growth has been of the order of 5% to 6%. A stock exchange was established in 1989 with the aim to finance the increasing investment needs of the future. The Freeport has become a major gateway between Asia and Africa. The island is expected to continue its development into a regional

centre for tourism, finance and education.

#### POPULAR TOUR TO THE SCENIC AND PANORAMIC SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE ISLAND!

Start at the extinct Trou aux Cerfs

volcanic crater with a 360° view over the island. At 'Voiliers de l'Ocean', see a display of stunning models of historical sailing ships. Continue to the sacred lake of Grand Bassin (Ganga Talao) followed by a stop at the viewpoint over the Black River Gorges, home to most of the island's endemic flora and fauna. Lunch is at the authentic village of Chamarel, where you will also visit the world-class La Rhumerie de Chamarel and taste some of the finest rum in the world. Admire the 90m-high Chamarel Waterfall and the iconic Seven-Coloured Earth. before returning to your hotel.

#### AN INTERESTING **KALEIDOSCOPE OF MAURITIUS**


**TRAIL**"

Visit the bustling and exciting capital city of Port-Louis! Enjoy the stunning view over

the capital city from Fort Adelaide, also known as the Citadel. Descend into the city, driving past the Champ de Mars, the first horseracing track built in the southern hemisphere. From St. Louis Cathedral, you will walk towards the centre, passing via the Theatre and Government House. Walk through the notorious Central Market and onwards to promenade along the Caudan Waterfront.

Enjoy an authentic Creole Lunch followed by a leisurely walk in the Pamplemousses Botanical Garden before returning to your hotel.

Optional: Visit the Blue Penny Museum, home to the famous Blue Penny stamp and a magnificent statue of Paul & Virginie. Entrance fee not included.

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# "THE DEEP SOUTH"









### TEA, TORTOISES AND LOTS OF NATURE!

The tea route starts in Curepipe, at the Colonial **Domaine des Aubineaux**, built in 1872. Continue to the **tea plantations of Bois Cheri**. Visit the factory and the museum, and enjoy a tea tasting. In the South, visit **La Vanille Nature Reserve** (Crocodile Park) and the Colonial estate of **Saint Aubin** (vanilla and anthurium plantations, an old sugar factory and the rum distillery, including a tasting followed by lunch). At **Gris Gris**, enjoy the view over the rugged basalt cliffs of the south coast where the sea throws wave after wave against the shore.

# **"THE NORTH"**



#### **ROLLING SUGAR CANE FIELDS, PICTURESQUE VILLAGES** AND TOWNS, AND A BIT OF **HISTORY!**

Visit the Chateau de Labourdonnais and admire the beautiful colonial architecture. Stop at the remarkable L'Aventure du Sucre (Sugar World) - an old sugar factory converted into a museum - to learn how the production of sugar has so heavily impacted Mauritian history and culture.

After lunch, tour the North coast: visit Anse La Raie, the iconic red-roofed chapel at Cap Malheureux, Bain Boeuf and Pereybere. Stop for a visit of x Grand Bay, including its popular "Bazaar", before returning to your hotel.

# **"MAHÉBOURG & ILE AUX AIGRETTES** NATURE RESERVE"





#### VISIT THE OLDEST AND MOST CHARACTERISTIC TOWN AND AN ISLAND NATURE RESERVE!

Start at the **Biscuiterie Rault**, an over 100-year-old **manioc (cassava) biscuit factory**, unique in the world, and sample these very special biscuits with a good cup of tea. Appreciate the authentic ambience of this old town during a short walk through the old streets and a visit of the **traditional market**. The pretty **Naval Museum** commemorates the famous **battle of Grand Port in 1810**. The very authentic Creole Lunch at **Karay Mario**, a small delightful restaurant is an exceptional experience. In the afternoon, visit **Ile aux Aigrettes**, the island nature reserve in the lagoon, and appreciate the conservation works done by the Mauritius Wildlife Foundation to preserve the endemic flora and fauna of Mauritius.

"Oplezir" is a large comfortable catamaran

(20m long). From **Black River**, look out for the numerous dolphins at home on the west coast. The chances of seeing them are excellent. There are 2 species of dolphins: '**Spinner**' and '**Bottlenose**' dolphins. Watch these delightful creatures for a while. Then enjoy some excellent snorkelling on the Coral Reef, surrounded by the magnificent scenery from **Tamarin Bay** down to the **Le Morne Mountain**.

After a BBQ lunch on board, you may explore **Benitiers Island** with its long sandy beach. Cruise back in the afternoon.

Enjoy a delicious BBQ lunch sitting on the sand. Beach walk or just relax before returning to Black River in the afternoon.

Half-day trips: return to the jetty after snorkelling. Please note that our partners are committed to observe official dolphin watching quidelines!

#### AN EXCITING WAY TO SEE THE HIDDEN TREASURES OF THE SOUTH

Ride a quad bike along the steep cliffs of the southern coast past the scenic 'Cascade Mamsel' to 'Gris Gris' and 'La Roche qui Pleure' (Crying Rock) - Head on through endless sugarcane fields past small villages, Hindu temple to the stunning 'Rochester Falls' - Drive along rivers and into the hills to the stunning 'Leon' waterfall - Swim in the clear water under the falls. The 'L'Exil' lodge is close by - relax with a tasty lunch while overlooking the fall.

Drive across the old 'Senneville Bridge' to La Vanille Nature Park for a visit before returning to base.

#### **LE MORNE MOUNTAIN, UNESCO** WORLD HERITAGE SITE

Hike up the iconic 'Le Morne Brabant' mountain in the southwest corner of Mauritius - Cover a steep elevation of about 500m to reach the 'V' pinnacle just below the top - 360° views are breath taking.

Other trails are: Black River Gorges - Black River Peak - Chamarel Waterfalls - La Tourelle - Trois Mamelles (Minimum age of 13 years old and difficulty level of 2 out of 5)

Electrobikes are now available at different parts of the island and with different routes to explore. Very popular is the Southern Route (3-4



hours) from Bel Ombre to Le Morne through Baie du Cap, Maconde Bay. At La Prairie, sample a drink of delicious coconut water. Discover Le Morne Village and its slavery history, and taste some 'Rotis' made by the locals of the village. Your representative will advise you about the locations.

# "ELECTROBIKES"







Driving in Mauritius is fun. We drive on the left and vehicles coming from the right have priority. Our roads are quite good but not always well indicated. A GPS works reasonably well and it is great fun to explore the island under your own steam. Rent a car from one of the numerous operators; they offer a large variety of vehicles. Drivers must be over 21 years.



Discover the rich history and culture of our capital, and taste the best street food Port Louis has to offer. Join this culinary journey, deep in the heart of our capital and experience authentic street food. Starting at the Caudan Waterfront, we will walk through Port Louis and stop at the best food spots for bite-sized delights. Sink your teeth into a warm roti, take a sip of freshly-squeezed juice, and let the flavours fuse.







See the stunning sights of Mauritius from the air. It is breathtaking. The various flight routes take you over endless sugar cane fields, wide lagoons fringed by the white waves on the coral reefs, the islands in the north, an underwater waterfall, rugged mountains and canyons with beautiful waterfalls. **Air Mauritius** has a fleet of 2 Bell Jet ranger for 4 passengers. **Corail Helicopters** have 2 EX120 B for 6 passengers. Tours last between 15 minutes to 1 hour, with various itineraries based on flight duration, helipad locations and weather conditions. Individual tours can also be arranged.
