







The Londoner Macao






Leisure Facilities

Arriving in Macao by Air

Macau International Airport (MFM)

Arriving in Macao from Airports at Neigbouring Regions

Hong Kong International Airport (HKG)

For visitors arriving via Hong Kong International Airport, there is an airport ferry service available. Passengers can transit into or out of Macao via Hong Kong International Airport without needing to go through Hong Kong Customs and Immigration formalities or pick up their baggage. All bags will be transferred from their international flight directly onto the ferry for collection in Macao. The trip to Macao is only 70 minutes. Besides, visitors can also use the airport shuttle bus to Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, then use Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge shuttle bus to Macao. 

Arriving in Macao by Land

High-Speed Train

There are several high-speed train routes that help connect Macao to most cities in mainland China. Visitors can now connect from cities such as Beijing and Guangzhou, a trip of only 8 hours with the high-speed trains, compared to 20 hours previously. From Guangzhou, visitors have the choice of a 46-minute, non-stop train to Zhuhai, the Macao-mainland China border, or 3 hours by coach.

The Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge

The Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge consists of a series of bridges and tunnels that connect Hong Kong, Macao and Zhuhai. As well as travelling by sea, travelers can now travel across the bridge from Hong Kong to Macao. For detailed information, please visit: www.hzmbus.com

From Hong Kong

Visitor can take One Bus, cross-border bus, from Jordan to The Venetian Macao, The Londoner Macao and Sands Macao. For detailed information, please visit: www.onebus.hk

Inside Guangdong

Visitors can take a bus to Zhuhai Gongbei Port or Hengqin Port, and pass through the border checkpoint. They can also take high-speed trains to Guangzhou South Station, then take Guangzhou-Zhuhai intercity railway to Zhuhai station and cross the border Gongbei or Qingmao checkpoint to Macao.

Outside Guangdong

Visitors can take high-speed trains to Guangzhou South Station then take Guangzhou-Zhuhai intercity railway to Zhuhai station and cross the Gongbei or Qingmao border checkpoint to Macao.

Arriving in Macao by Sea

From Hong Kong

Visitors can take the ferry from Hong Kong Macau Ferry Terminal (Sheung Wan) to Macau Taipa Ferry Terminal or Macau Outer Harbour Ferry Terminal.

Macao Light Rapid Transit (LRT)

The Macao Light Rapid Transit (LRT) is the first rapid transit system in Macao. The 12.5 km Taipa line covers Taipa, Cotai and Barra in Macao Penisula, connecting hotels, attractions, border gate, ferry terminal and Macau International Airport.

Complimentary Shuttle Bus

We offer a complimentary shuttle bus every 10-15 minutes from the Cotai Strip, Macao peninsula, ferry terminals, Macau International Airport, Gongbei and Hengqin Port.

Others
