

We apologise

You have probably read or heard that we have had a serious problem with three frozen beef burger products that we sell in stores in the UK and Ireland.

The Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) has told us that a number of products they have recently tested from one of our suppliers contained horsemeat.

While the FSAI has said that the products pose no risk to public health, we appreciate that, like us, our customers will find this absolutely unacceptable.

The products in our stores were Tesco Everyday Value 8 x Frozen Beef Burgers (397g), Tesco 4 x Frozen Beef Quarter Pounders (454g) and a branded product, Flamehouse Frozen Chargrilled Quarter Pounders.

We have immediately withdrawn from sale all products from the supplier in question, from all our stores and online.

If you have any of these products at home, you can take them back to any of our stores at any time and get a full refund. You will not need a receipt and you can bring back just the packaging.

We and our supplier have let you down and we apologise



Responsible sourcing

Level of assurance Includes goods and services, suppliers and contractors Legitimately secured procurement from legal and well-managed sources

Address organisational governance, supply chain management and economic, environmental and social aspects of sourcing.

Responsible materials procurement policy statement

This statement sets out Mace's strategic commitment to the procurement and management of materials.

Mace is responsible for specifying and procuring large quantities of materials for construction projects and associated services. We specify and procure directly, working with our supply chain partners and indirectly through the advice we provide to our clients.

We recognise that the choices we make and the advice we provide can have significant direct and indirect impacts upon people and the environment. We have a narrowner of responsible procurement commitments in place to address these risks, which includes membership of SEDEX, the Suppler Elihical Data Exchange platform, to may our approve chain risks and assess etitical standards.

Advisory Services

Where Mace acts is an arbitrory capacity and does not specify materials, we advise our client of this policy provide relevant guidance and seek assurance that responsibly-sourced materials are speciated and procease. Con intend is to ensue that we other responsible sourcing recommendations in 100% of indirect influence by 2022.

Training and supply chain engagement

Mace people receive training on how to meet the requirements of this policy, in accordance with their role and we actively engage with key clients and supply chain partners to ensure that the aims of this policy are delivered.






