Accredited Register set up by the Professional Standards Authority for Health and Social Care (PSA) in 2013.

There are 10 health and care regulators for professionals working in occupations that Parliament has said must be regulated. For example, doctors, nurses, pharmacists and paramedics.

Not everyone working in health and social care is regulated by law, which is why there are accredited registers.

Accredited registers have met the robust standards set by the government-appointed accrediting body - the PSA.

Accredited registers are voluntary.



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Regulation benefits the public

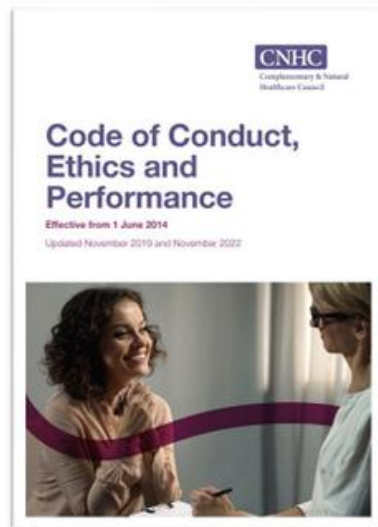
It's there to make sure professionals are safe to practise.

3. **Declaring** and upholding professional standards

How the CNHC Regulates

- Provide an independent UK-wide register of complementary healthcare practitioners.
- Set the standards practitioners need to meet to get onto and stay on our register.
- Investigate concerns and take any necessary action.

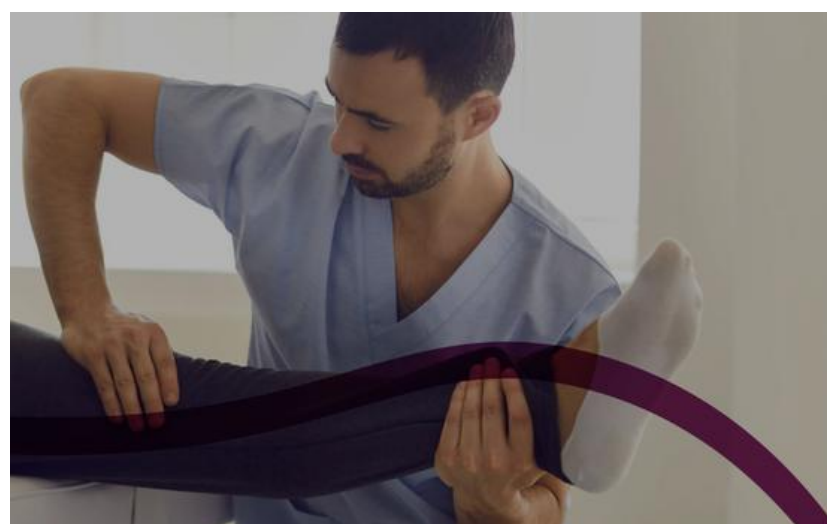

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How to register with CNHC

Steps	Your Journey to Registration	What Happens Next
1	Apply through a relevant Verifying Organisation	Your Verifying Organisation confirms that your training and education meets the standards required for CNHC registration.
2	Look out for an invitation email from CNHC	If you're eligible you will receive an email notification from CNHC inviting, you to complete the registration process online .
3	Complete your application online	Login, provide the requested information and pay the annual registration fee (£75 for your first discipline).
4	Join the Register	Become CNHC registered, use the CNHC Quality Mark and demonstrate your commitment to recognised professional standards.
