

Sustainable Graphic Solutions

Our sister company (and in-house graphics supplier) **Psycho Peacock** provides all the signage and graphics for all Full Circle events. Recent developments on the large format printing technology have been driven by sustainability and the reduction in the amount of energy used to produce a graphic.

Whenever possible Full circle utilise a PVC Free option. Currently all tension fabric and grey backed graphics are printed on PVC free. It is widely known that not all materials can be fully recycled, new developments in substrates have introduced highly and even fully recyclable materials along with bio-degradable ones.

We remove all printed graphics/signage from the events we service, following our Reduce, Reuse, Recycle motto, allowing us to ensure that they will be recycled responsibly. As not all media can be fully recycled, we have adopted a different approach to enhance their eco-friendliness.

Psycho Peacock has increased the use of water-based inks and the Canon Colorado has GREENGUARD Gold Certification.

Water-based inks don't contain any of the toxic chemicals of it's Plastisol counterparts (no PVC, no phthalates). Instead it's comprised of naturally occurring substances.

RE-BOARD

Made from 80% paper fibre, the core is made up of 97% air 3% Polystyrene. The product is PVC free and uses 50% less energy to produce than corrugated board. Due to it's light weight, transportation emissions are lower. When used in energy recovery the core becomes water steam.



BLACK BACK FABRIC BANNER WRAPS

A high quality polyester textile, with a total block out black reverse. Completely PVC free – 100% recyclable

DISPA

The ultimate sustainable display board is made from 100% paper and is 100% recyclable and an alternative to standard Foamex infill panels, this lightweight option still offers the high level of rigidity however the boards can simply and inexpensively be disposed as waste paper.





GLAZIER BLACKBACK FABRIC

Putting sustainability in the spotlight - PVC-free fabric lightbox display products made from fully recycled PET yarns. Investing in the Vertex Marine range which is made of 100% polyester fabric made entirely from recycled plastic bottles offers a sustainable yet premium solution for event branding.


Recycled Floor Covering

Our floorcovering partners MJ's aim to conduct their business with environmentally friendly operational practices, promoting protection of the environment and minimising any negative impact that may occur from operations. Management processes ensure that environmental factors are considered during planning and implementation, adhering to environmental codes of practice.

Suppliers and subcontractors are encouraged to implement good environmental practices and procedures which support our own objectives and targets. The chosen recycling partner has 12 years 'experience in recycling exhibition carpet; they collect all carpet, ensures it meets the processing requirements and turn it into PP pellets.

To ensure the latest recycling methods are used and comply with all current regulations, our partners are members of Carpet Recycling UK, the leading association dedicated to finding better ways of reusing or recycling used carpet.

ROAR B2B WILL CONSIDER THE USE OF AISLE CARPET ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS TO REDUCE CONSUMPTION AND WASTE. WHEN THE EXHIBITION CLOSES ITS DOORS, ALL STAND FLOOR COVERINGS WILL be COLLECTED FOR RECYCLING THE RAW MATERIALS ARE REPURPOSED INTO NEW PRODUCTS FOR INDUSTRY, CONSUMERS, AND LOCAL COMMUNITIES.

REPURPOSED CARPET PRODUCTS Repurposed products from our carpet include:

- Mouldings, non-aesthetical parts, spare tyre holders, air duct filters, wheel arch liners, car floor mats for the automotive industry
- Plant pots and garden furniture
- Pallets and crates
- Furniture and furniture filling
- Carpet slippers and bags

Zero Waste Electrical Cabling

Full Circle invested heavily in a modular stand building system made from aluminium, that can be endlessly reused.

We opt for a 100% reusable end product and for sustainable materials. Did you know aluminium is the most commonly found metal on our planet? It's strong, yet light. It has a long life cycle and is fully renewable. This results in greener and smarter solutions for everyone.

The recycling process only requires about 5% of the energy compared to the production of primary aluminium. We can say that at least 75% of our frames are produced from recycled aluminium. Another impressive fact: 75% of all the aluminium ever produced is still in use.
