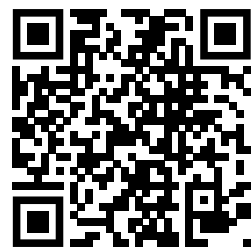

The powerchair mitts main purpose is for the control joystick hand but due to its **Patented Design** another can easily be converted for the non controller hand by simply closing the flap on the mitt sealing the aperture from the elements and attaching to the non controller arm keeping both hands waterproof and dry.

Having both forearms and hands on the the arms of the powerchair results in the user sitting in a proper upright position which is needed for correct posture.

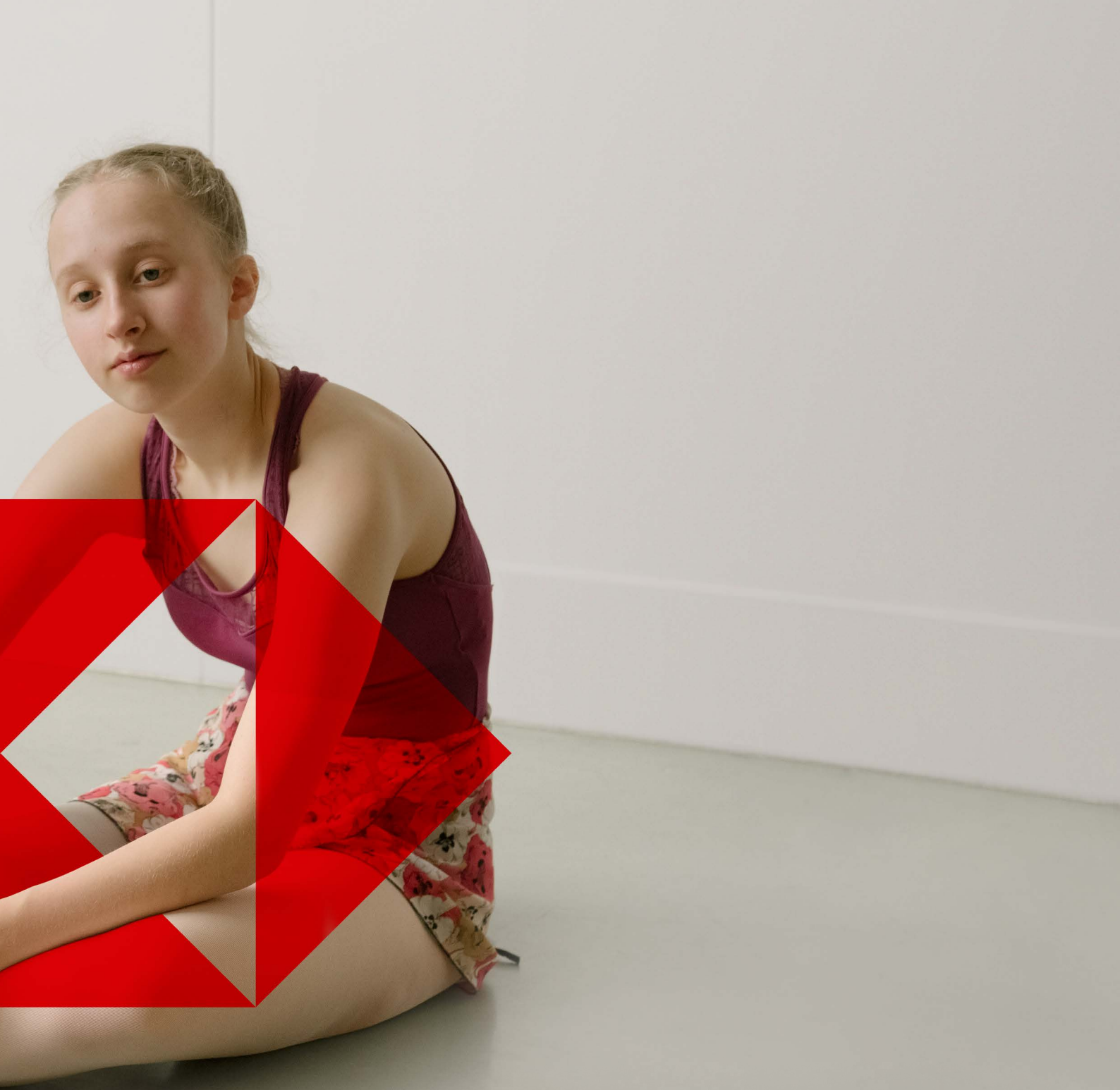

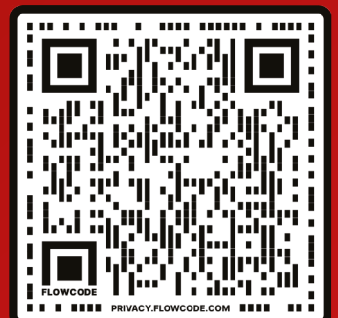
