### Where AI can help in journalistic workflow


- Story ideas
  - What angle should I take?
  - What else has been written about this subject?
  - What experts/sources should I talk to?
  - OpenAI/Google Gemini "Deep Research"
- Interview prep
  - What do I need to know about this topic or person?
  - What questions might I ask?





## Deep Research from ChatGPT & Gemini

### More journalistic workflow

- Information gathering
  - Unstructured data extraction
  - Information discovery (needle in a haystack)
  - Web scraping
  - Transcribe public meeting recordings
- Editing help
  - Headline suggestions (SEO optimized)
  - Style guide checker

You are a helpful research assistant. I am going to upload text files and want you to extract specific information from them in JSON format using the following schema: { "Issuing State:" "US state issuing document",

"Decision Date:" "Date of document/letter. Display as MM-DD-YYYY",

"Name:" "Name of individual to which the letter/order is written to",

"City:" "City in which the individual resides",

"State:" "State in which the individual resides",

"Crime:" "Specific offense to which individual pleaded guilty or was convicted of",

"Crime location:" "Type of court and location of court where individual pleaded guilty or was convicted",

"Conviction date:" "Date of guilty plea or conviction. If full date, display as MM-DD-YYYY. If only year display as YYYY",

"Crime summary:" "Summary of crime or crimes and any explanation",

## ChatGPT response

# Response (cont.)

#### Step 2: Decide on Inputs

- Enterior Tone (optional: e.g., neutral, urgent, emotional, professional, conversational)
- @ Target Audience (optional: e.g., investors, regulators, general public)
- Character Limit (optional: e.g., 60 or 70 for SEO purposes)

#### Step 3: Decide on Output Format

- A list of 5–10 headline suggestions, each tailored for SEO (keyword inclusion, length under 60–70 chars, etc.)
- Maybe a quick score/rationale for why each one is SEO-friendly



## Response (cont.)

#### Step 4: Write the Instructions (System Prompt)

This is what you'll feed into the customGPT as instructions. Here's a sample:

#### System Prompt for CustomGPT:

"You are an expert SEO editor and headline writer. Your job is to create multiple, SEO-optimized headline suggestions for news stories. Headlines should be:

- "Under 60 characters (unless otherwise specified)"
- "Include relevant keywords for search optimization"
- "Be engaging and clear"
- "Adapted to the specified tone or audience, if provided. Return 5–10 headline options with short notes on what makes them effective (optional)."

Input will include a story summary or full story text, and optionally: keywords, tone, character limit, and target audience."



# Response (cont.)

#### Step 5: Create It on ChatGPT

To build this in ChatGPT, go to: https://chat.openai.com/gpts

- 1. Click "Explore GPTs" and then "Create"
- 2. Choose Create a GPT
- 3. Use the instructions from above as your Custom Instructions
- 4. In the "Conversation starters," add examples like:
  - "Suggest SEO headlines for this story: [paste text]"
  - "Give me 5 headlines under 60 characters with the keyword 'cybersecurity'"

#### Optional: Add File or Link Input

If you want to feed URLs or documents (e.g., a Google Doc or news article), you can enable tools like **web browsing** or **file upload** — ChatGPT will extract content and work from there.
