Showcase how to entertain with plants, you could choose to transform a space into an appealing area for wildlife, bring colour to a dark corner or challenge yourself to get plants flourishing in a tricky patch challenged by arid/alkaline soil or complete shade. The border could bring joy to a city school or a technicolour flash in a concrete corner.

Your space can be entirely creative and not necessarily technical, let your imagination take over, we can't wait to see what creative borders come out of this year's theme.


