

#### Agapanthus 'Fireworks'

A highly commended finalist in the prestigious RHS Chelsea Flower Show Plant of the Year competition, Agapanthus 'Fireworks' is an easy-to-maintain variety that boasts big, exotic-looking, two-tone flowers that won't fade in colour. Upright white buds open to show off pretty hanging flowers with stunning blue bases and flaring white petal tips which keep blooming long after other agapanthus are finished - often well into September. Its evergreen foliage can withstand winter temperatures of -10C - and as a hardy perennial, it will come back each year, looking bigger and better each time.





# Chilli 'Spicy Jane'

The leaves have a beautiful shine and their structure secures low water use, making them ideal for hanging baskets. The plants are quick in showing fruit and the fruit colours fast. Plus they will continue to produce new fruit in quick succession once you begin to harvest them! Plants grow to around 25cm tall before beginning to cascade.

#### Chlorophytum saundersiae 'Starlight'

This elegant grass-like perennial forms a dense clump of slender, variegated foliage that shoot upwards before arching gracefully at the tips. Unlike its better known, house plant relative – the Spider Plant, Chlorophytum saundersiae 'Starlight' is hardy to -5C (41F) making it suitable for a sheltered spot outdoors. Throughout summer it produces starry, white flowers that sparkle at the tips of its long stems. Height: 100cm (39"). Spread: 45cm (18").

# Clematis 'Little Lemons'

Instantly recognisable as a C. tangutica variety, but without the sprawling stems of its larger cousins! Clematis 'Little Lemons' is a super-dwarf plant with a neat, bushy habit. The short, 45cm (18") long stems are cloaked in delicately cut, bright green foliage. A host of nodding, lemon-yellow blooms decorate this dwarf plant from May to September. Terminal buds are replaced by fluffy seed heads as the flowers fade, providing a lovely textural display which extends the season of interest by several weeks.

#### Cosmos Sulphureus 'Mandarin'

Flowering from Spring to Autumn, Mandarin has a deeper orange colour, a better habit and is more uniform compared to competing varieties. Mandarin performs best in sun and partial sun. Reaching a height of 25-30cm, it is a slightly more compact variety offering a more mounded shape.

# Delphinium 'Cinderella'

Robust, cold tolerant, and disease-proof, the stems are strong like bamboo, not flimsy like traditional delphiniums and at just four feet tall, they're great for small borders or large containers on the patio. The development of a triple layered bloom gives far more longevity too. Single-flowered varieties often fade quickly and shatter when the winds come. The pompon structure of 'Cinderella' stays intact far longer. Plants are hardy and flower not once, but TWICE a year, in summer and again in autumn!





#### Ipomoea batatus 'Sunpuma Purple'

#### Iris 'Ensata'

#### Malus toringo 'Aros'








#### Toona sinensis 'Beef and Onion'
