




This classic limestone paving, pale in colour, really adds character to any landscaping scheme. Perfect for any contemporary or traditional design, our Purbeck limestone paving is characterised by its grey and buff tones.

#### **CHAWTON PURBECK**

Paving: Available in 250/325/400mm x random lengths x 30-50mm thick.

#### SANDITON PURBECK

<u>Paving</u>: Available in 300 x random lengths x 50mm thick.

<u>Pitchers</u>: Available in 30-60mm width x 75-100mm depth x random lengths (Tumbled is optional).

<u>Setts</u>: Available in 100mm wide x running lengths x 50-75mm and 100mm wide x running lengths x 75-100mm.

#### York stone

York Stone is a beautiful, traditional British Sandstone that has been used for centuries where hardwearing surface is required. We stock 7 styles of York stone paving, all of which have a timeless appeal and are long lasting.

### LAMBTON SELF-FACED YORK STONE

Classic and dark in colour, this stone has a naturally self-faced surface with gentle indentations, caused where it was possible to ease the layered beds of rock away from each other.


#### CARDALE RIVEN YORK STONE: A VARIANT OF LAMBTON

Naturally, riven surface. Approx. 50% of the pavers will have a riven surface with others being smooth. Classic and Dark in colour.

#### **Formats**

#### Lambton Self Faced:

Available in 600mm x random lengths x 38-65mm thick (Avg. 50mm). Also available in 30mm thickness, suitable for foot traffic.



#### BARSET SAWN YORK STONE

Slabs have a smooth, sawn surface. Constant Green and Brown in colour. Various formats available.

#### **EARNSHAW SAWN YORK**

Paving with a diamond sawn finish. Hard, British sandstone with a medium to coarse grained texture. Golden Buff tones through to Absolute Grey. Some slabs will feature veining of both colours. Various formats available

#### **Formats**

#### Barset sawn:

- <u>Pavers</u>: Available in 400/500/600mm x random lengths x 50mm thick and 900mm x 600mm x 50mm thick.
- Setts: Available in 75mm thick (Tumbled).

#### Earnshaw sawn:

- Pavers: Available in 600/450mm x random lengths x 40mm thick, 900mm x 600mm x 40mm thick.
- Setts: 250mm x 150mm x 50mm thick.

#### Linton riven paving:

Available in 600mm x random lengths x 38-70mm thick.

#### LINTON BRITISH YORK STONE

Hard, British sandstone with a medium to coarse grained texture. This paving has Golden to Buff tones. Available in Riven and sawn formats.

#### **BAMPTON SAWN YORK STONE**

Offered in 2 tones, this is a sawn paving. Available in a Buff and Grey version — the difference between them are more visible when wet than dry.

#### Linton Golden Buff sawn:


- <u>Paving</u>: Available in 600/450mm x random lengths x 40mm thick,
   900mm x 600mm x 40mm thick.
- <u>Setts</u>: Available in 250mm x 150mm x 50mm thick, 200mm x 100mm x 40mm thick, 100mm x 100mm x 40mm thick.

#### Bampton sawn:

Available in 400/500/600mm x random lengths x 50mm thick.

#### Cardale riven:

Available in  $600 \text{mm} \times \text{random}$  lengths  $\times 38-70 \text{mm}$  thick.





#### Portland stone

This sparkling creamy limestone paving has featured in our architecture in the British Isles for centuries. Available in 2 styles, Hardy is a smooth, classic creamy white paving stone and Casterbridge is a greyer version with a bush hammered finish to give a look of authenticity.

#### All styles

Sawn: Available in several formats (not exceeding)  $1200 \times 750 \text{mm} \times 50 \text{mm}$  thick.

#### Pennant stone

A classic British sandstone, Pennant sandstone paving can be seen across the entire country, where it has been used to create classic street and landscape schemes. Its reserved appearance blends well with traditional landscapes.



#### Gritstone

Sourced from Northumberland, British gritstone is a very hardwearing stone paving. Its traditional hues of greys, buffs and orange grits will enhance any landscape design, with each style offering its own distinctive colour tone and markings.

Our five Northumberland grit stones each have a distinctive character of their own.

#### **BRANWELL**

Fine grained creamy buff.

#### **HAWORTH**

Light buff medium grained stone.

#### **HEATHCLIFF**

A coarse-grained brown and grey, variegated sandstone, with occasional large quartz inclusions. Featuring striking grey veins.

#### **THORNTON**

A fine-grained blue/grey gritstone.

#### WILDFELL

A medium grained British gritstone paver displaying a blend of orange and grey grits.







This exquisite garden, created in a rural landscape setting, features our beautiful Great British Stone Selection as well as a contemporary pool lined with porcelain tiles.








#### Breath-taking British stone

We supplied our stunning Lambton self faced York stone in the landscaped areas surrounding the pool house and tennis court.

Made up of layers, this beautiful stone is available in both a 38-70mm thickness and a thinner 25-35mm version which was used for the paving. Steps have been created using the thicker 38-70mm slabs as step treads, throughout the garden to accommodate to the truly amazing rural landscape the property is located within.


The earthy, traditional tones of Lambton York stone add such elegance to a landscape design. Its subtle colouring truly allows it to sit perfectly within this project as it brings contemporary and natural elements together.



#### Beautiful Barset sawn York stone infinity pool

In this prestigious project Stoneworld supplied the Barset sawn York stone Paving. We also fabricated many specific items for this project in our masonry factory, such as the York stone pool copings. These pool copings were made to measure with a bullnosed front edge. Concealed inspection lids, lighting channels, stone seating areas and step treads were all made to order in our factory.

We also devised a way of fixing submerged sliced Great British glacial boulders to the bottom of the pool for decorative effect, as per the customer's specification.
