The 14th edition of the International Petroleum Technology Conference (IPTC) attracted over **13,200 attendees** from **2,690 companies**, and **74 countries**.

This successful edition returned to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in 2022, building on the strong foundation established by IPTC 2020 which was the first international multi-disciplinary, inter-society oil and gas conference and exhibition to be held in the Kingdom. IPTC 2022 received the patronage of His Royal Highness Prince Mohammed bin Salman bin Abdulaziz Al-Saud, Crown Prince, Deputy Prime Minister, and Minister of Defense of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, with Saudi Aramco serving as the exclusive host.

Founded in 2005, IPTC is sponsored by four of the leading industry organisations in oil and gas: the American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG); the European Association of Geoscientists and Engineers (EAGE); the Society of Exploration Geophysicists (SEG); and the Society of Petroleum Engineers (SPE). IPTC is focused on the dissemination of new and current technologies, best practices and multi-disciplinary activities designed to emphasise the importance of the value chain and maximising asset value.



Themed ***Fuelling Global Recovery Through Sustainable Energy***, this edition of IPTC focused on upstream sector resilience, technological advancement, and ecosystem evolution in the industry.

IPTC BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The IPTC Board of Directors was formed in June 2010 to oversee the management of IPTC. The Board is made up of members elected from IPTC's four organising societies.

Members of the Board are appointed to three-year terms. The two principal officers, the Chairman and the Vice Chairman, are elected to two-year terms by the Board during their annual meeting.

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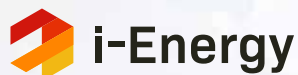

Technical Sessions at IPTC 2022

100+ technical sessions took place across the three days, covering a range of disciplines, including geosciences, reservoir engineering, drilling and completions, sustainability, midstream operations, IOR/EOR, production engineering, unconventional, IR 4.0 and overarching themes.

In total, the Programme Committee reviewed more than **4,200 paper submissions** and selected more than **800** to form the technical agenda.



IPTC 2022 Features

IPTC Society Presidents Panel Session

The IPTC Society Presidents Panel Session featured the presidents of IPTC's four sponsoring societies, the American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG), the European Association of Geoscientists and Engineers (EAGE), the Society of Exploration Geophysicists (SEG), and the Society of Petroleum Engineers (SPE).

They shared their perspectives about their visions and how the latest technological advances are shaping the future of the industry.



Ask the Expert Sessions

All 3 finalists presented the details of their projects and answered audience questions in a special 90-minute session during the conference.

Young Member Activities

Education Week

This programme aims to give students from around the world a clear insight into the industry they are about to join and provide them with the opportunity to interact with a number of major industry employers who are looking to recruit the best talent from institutions around the world.

This year, over **450 student applications** were received globally, of which **86 students** representing **44 institutions and 17 countries participated** in this year's Education Week.

During the five-day programme, students were divided into groups to work on this year's challenge—an updated version of the 'Unlock the Reserves' challenge, which was initially introduced in 2020 in collaboration with Schlumberger. The students also had the chance to attend the IPTC exhibition and sessions, as well as participate in a Geo Steering Challenge and professional development sessions tailored specifically for Education Week students. Lastly, students were treated to an inspiring field trip to Dahil Heet Cave to learn the story of oil discovery in Saudi Arabia, followed by a visit to the traditional Najd Village where students had a taste of local culture and cuisine.

Science Teachers Workshop

The IPTC Science Teachers Workshop highlighted how energy works, and provided school teachers from the Kingdom with interactive, age-appropriate experiments using basic household items to illustrate energy concepts. The idea of the experiments is that they can be brought straight to the classroom with ease, and in a sustainable manner. The workshop welcomed over **40 science teachers**.

Emerging Leaders Forum

This exciting one-day forum offered the opportunity for young professionals to get together for an interactive day of education, inspiration, and collaboration. The day opened with a Leadership Panel, featuring Ghassan Mirdad, Schlumberger, and Einas Alashgar, Spark, followed by a 'Dive into Deep Learning,' with talks about negotiation skills from Lisa Silipigno, Schlumberger, and personal branding from Najwa Azaimi, Saudi Aramco. In the afternoon, the young leaders participated in an interactive group session allowing them to put their newly learned skills to work—splitting into small groups, they worked on two real-life inspired CEO case studies under the guidance of Madhi Al-Adel, Saudi Aramco Ventures, and Deem Al-Bassam, SALT and Parkers Restaurants. The event welcomed emerging leaders from around the world.

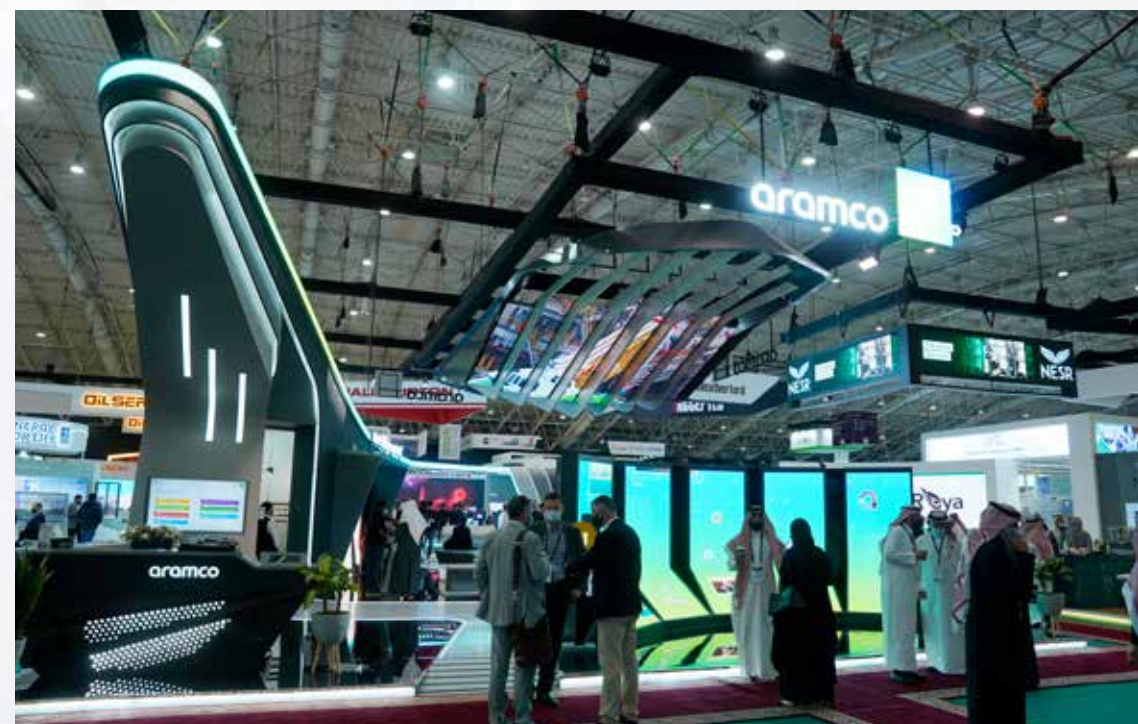


World-Class Exhibition at IPTC 2022

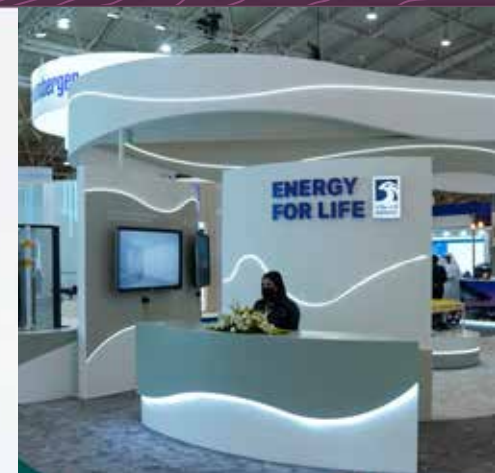
