KEYNOTE LUNCHEON

Timothy Latimer, Co-Founder and Chief Executive Officer of Fervo Energy delivered a compelling keynote as he explored how this coming decade will be defined by geothermal's rise from a niche resource to a cornerstone of the global energy mix.



PRESIDENT'S LUNCHEON

At the President's Luncheon and Annual Meeting of Members, 2025 SPE President Olivier Houzé delivered the "State of the Society" address, reflecting on a year of reflection and resolve. He emphasized SPE's adaptation to change and its enhanced relevance going forward.

Houzé also announced the completion of the EnRG LLM project (in partnership with Aramco Americas and i2k Connect) which SPE will now license to industry partners.

Olivier Houzé passed the gavel to the 2026 SPE President Jennifer Miskimins, department head of petroleum engineering at Colorado School of Mines. Miskimins expressed her vision: to inspire members to progress from ideas to action, with focus on upskilling workforce, attracting and retaining talent, and deepening our role in the global energy discussion.
