At **Sifted Summit**, we're all about making sure everyone feels welcome and included. Here's how we're making our event accessible:

Venue accessibility

- Step-free access to the venue and throughout key areas (entrance, networking, stages, toilets)
- Accessible toilets clearly signposted and regularly cleaned
- Venue map with accessible routes and entrances highlighted
- Clear signage with large fonts and high contrast
- Companions welcome
- There are quiet spaces and a prayer room accessible at the venue

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Communication Accessibility

- Live captioning for all panels, interviews and workshops
- There are hearing loops and live captions at all stages
- Any slide decks can be shared in advance if requested
- Large print agendas and floorplans are at the registration desk
- Assistance dogs are welcome
- Reserved seating for those who require it in all stages

Transportation

- The venue is easily accessible by public transport and car, with step-free access. There is no on-site parking, so we recommend planning your journey in advance if travelling by car

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Families and babies

- We warmly welcome parents and carers with babies to attend
- A private, comfortable space for feeding or changing will be available — please ask a member of staff for directions
- You're welcome to bring prams or pushchairs; the venue has step-free options
- Noise is understood — we support parents doing their best and won't ask anyone to leave for tending to a baby

Emergency Planning

- Specific evacuation procedures for disabled guests
- Venue staff trained in assisting people with limited mobility or sensory sensitivities
