Mostly carved from walrus ivory in the late 12th and early 13th century, they were found 700 years later in the vicinity of Uig on the Isle of Lewis. 3D laser scans were taken of some of the pieces in our collection to create these authentic poly-resin replicas. The draughts counters in this set are replicas, from the collections of National Museums Scotland, of bone playing pieces, discovered in the Inner Hebrides. The counter depicting the crowned mermaid is late 15th-century and was found in Iona Abbey, whilst the other, early16th-century piece, with carved interlacing, was found on the island of Rhum.







# Galloway Hoard

The Galloway hoard contains the richest and most varied range of Viking-age objects ever discovered in Britain and Ireland – silver arm rings, ingots, gold, glass beads, jewels, two rare rock crystal objects and Scotland's first discovery of Anglo-Saxon disc brooches. Many of these beautiful items are unique including a gold bird-pin, reminiscent of a phoenix and a quatrefoil brooch, comically depicting two of the senses – sight and sound!







Phoebe Anna Traquair (1852–1936) was one of the foremost artists of her generation and a leading light of the Arts and Crafts movement. Multi-talented and prolific, her work encompassed embroidery, enamelwork, manuscript illumination and murals, amongst others.
