My company Vivid Stash began in early 2021 offering digital cross stitch patterns to lovers of bold colour and humour. Given the success of selling worldwide in 2022 I began selling kits in the UK.

My design principles have the stitcher's experience at heart. Easily readable patterns, simple stitches, quality materials and fun.

In recent years cross stitch has seen a huge rise in popularity, as more people seek ways to re-charge, have time away from screens, and if needed stab something a thousand times!

# Introducing the Wild Scotland collection

Beginner cross stitch kits showcasing Scottish icons against the background of a brand new tartan, exclusively designed by Vivid Stash.

Each icon is named and each kit contains everything needed to start stitching straight away. Perfect as gifts or a pastime whilst touring Scotland.

As of October 2023 the tartan, named Stash Tartan, has been certified by the Scottish Register of Tartans.

This certification would not be possible without a unique, pleasing design and purpose.



The tartan is made using five colours. As each colour is added the piece is transformed, taking the stitcher on a unique journey.

As nowhere else in the world has this tartan, and the format is so unusual, the Wild Scotland collection offers a completely original product to the gift and craft market.







Introducing Andrew the Stag, Barb the Thistle, Harris the Highland Cow and Blair the Scottie Dog. True icons of Scotland, showcased for the first time in Stash Tartan.

The colours of the designs are bright and bold to entice a new audience to the beauty of tartan.

Different versions are available to give choice in the size of piece and time spent stitching that the buyer would prefer.

These kits are the very first of their kind and I can promise they are a delight to stitch. Each kit offers the stitcher a way to make their very own piece of Scotland.

All designs in this collection fit easily within a 5" embroidery hoop which is provided within the kit, perfect for beginners or as a gift.



## Launching January 2024

Brand new for 2024 eight portraits of Scottish culture.

As an example of the Scottish wilderness the creatures of Archibald the Puffin, Sandy the Squirrel and Loch Nessie.

In honour of our coastline the Lighthouse in two versions. A humorous nod to our national conversation about the weather with the sun, clouds and an umbrella.

Lastly the bagpipes. Our national instrument. Many may be unable to play it but at least a stitched version is possible.

Each kit is named to give personality to the project and has resulted in many customers curating their own series based on their favourite characters.



Tartan is synonymous with the festive season. Giving the traditional favourites an update I present:

Roddy the Reindeer
Roddy the Reindeer Encircled
Stash Tartan Wreath
Christmas Tree
Christmas Tree Encircled

Each kit is designed so that stitching can begin as soon as the box is opened.

The embroidery hoop included not only is used to aid stitching but can be used to frame the project as a wall hanging or tree decoration, or as a completed gift- as long as they appreciate the effort!

- DMC threads, world leader in embroidery thread production
- DMC 16 count aida fabric, pre-cut crisp fabric
- Embroidery hoop, for maintaining tension whilst stitching
- Needle, size 26
- Chart, b/w printed for clear symbol reading
- Key chart, threads are pre-sorted for stitcher's convenience
- Needle threader, to make threading easier
- Instructions, A4 double sided, explains basics of stitching, designed by Vivid Stash
