We're an innovative Scottish brand specialising in luxuriously soft alpaca wool accessories. Our products are simple and versatile, in an array of colours inspired by the rugged mountainous scenery of Wester Ross. Each design is beautifully made and finished by hand by our artisans in Peru where alpaca is the centre of a rich textile heritage and was once treasured by Inca Royalty.

Alpaca is a species of camel which has inhabited the high plains of the Andes of South America for at least 6000 years, spanning the borders of Peru, Bolivia and Chile. This area, known as the Altiplano, is about 4000 metres above sea level. Alpacas have adapted to living at such high altitudes, developing a fine micron hair with a hollow fibre which is exceptionally insulating. So why choose alpaca? Here are 7 good reasons:

- Buttery softness uniquely smooth and silky
- Hard-wearing and doesn't pill or bobble
- High warmth to weight ratio compared to other wools
- Natural, hypo-allergenic & low prickle factor
- $\bullet~$ Moisture-wicking & anti-microbial
- Squashes to nothing and bounces back uncreased
- Alpacas are eco-friendly (see overleaf)

6 reasons why Alpacas are good for our planet

- Alpacas tread lightly on this earth. They have dainty soft padded two toe feet unlike other grazing herds. This helps prevent trampling plants and eroding fragile hillside.
- Alpacas eat gently. While many grazing animals pull the grass up by the roots with their teeth, alpaca just nibble the tips, carefully leaving the roots intact so plants can regrow.
- Alpacas are abstemious and only eat what they need. They
 consume less than half the amount per day that sheep do
 and like other camels, they don't need to drink much either!
- Alpaca wool doesn't contain lanolin and therefore needs much less processing than sheep's wool. No harsh chemicals and very little water needed.
- Alpaca poop is very rich in nitrogen and potassium compared to other herds, making it an ideal fertiliser! It's also easy to pick up as alpaca like to poop in one place!
- Alpaca wool is 100% Biodegradable and Renewable, meaning it can decompose naturally and can be regrown by the animal. It's also a durable and long-lasting material that can replace synthetic fibres that contribute to the pollution of our planet. You could successfully compost one of our cardigans, although we'd prefer you to wear it for as long as possible first!
