
# British Alpaca

### Undyed alpaca + rose fibre



Our alpaca collection is crafted from a luxurious blend of 85% undyed British alpaca and 15% rose fibre. By working with small British breeders, we hand-select only the finest fleeces - just 5–10% of alpacas produce fibre of this quality - chosen for their softness, lustre, fineness, and natural colour.

The alpaca remains completely undyed, allowing its natural shades of caramel, white, and grey to shine through in timeless harmony with any interior. Blended with innovative rose fibre, the fabric is enhanced with a subtle sheen, added strength, and durability, while remaining hypoallergenic, insulating, and irresistibly soft.

Every piece celebrates the beauty of nature and the landscapes that inspire us, with full traceability back to the farm.






### The packaging

### The designs

Rooted in the rich agricultural landscape of Aberdeenshire, Araminta's newest alpaca designs celebrate the beauty and rhythm of the barley fields that surround her home during the early and late harvest season in Scotland.





### **Rippling Barley**

Rippling Barley evokes a moment in motion - when the barley stands tall in the fields and the wind stirs the crop into rippling waves. Inspired by this natural, undulating pattern, Araminta has translated the movement into a flowing design that echoes the way the fields come alive.





### Harvest Grain

Harvest Grain captures the structure of the barley as it grows - the elegant head of the plant with its central stem and fine, tapering awns. This intricate natural form has been transformed into a repeating motif that honours the delicate symmetry and quiet strength of the growing crop.




### Fern
