


The 1834 Chestnut Tan, worn as a beltbag



Welcoming the new Ailsa bag to the NIXEY collection! It's quietly elegant and simple design makes the Ailsa a wardrobe classic, perfect for everyday wear.

At NIXEY we love putting a modern twist on traditional shapes & our Ailsa is a true testament to that. The design of this curvaceous little cross-body is a modern reinterpretation of a centuries-old design. The Ailsa pays homage to NIXEY's Scottish heritage, deriving its shape from the Scottish dress sporran.



Beautifully crafted & hard-wearing, NIXEY bags are designed for the outdoors. The Ailsa bag is no exception. It takes its name from Ailsa Craig, an oval-shaped island 16 km west of mainland Scotland.







Named PORTOBELLO, after the coastal suburb of Edinburgh and the famous London market where we first started selling our bags back in 2017.


