ITAD = Repairer?

The 'Independent Repairer' Label:

Under the standard definition any independent provider of repair services is considered a 'repairer':

- To provide a repair for a customer
- Or to repair with the aim to resell.

Hence, this includes independent ITADs and Refurbishers.



Manufacturer Obligations:

1. Provide a repair, when requested, unless repair is impossible;
2. Obligation Applies Even if Manufacturer Is Outside the EU
3. Carry out the repair for free or at a reasonable price, within a reasonable time;
4. **Make available, for a reasonable price, spare parts & tools to repairers;**
5. **Obligation to Provide Repair Information Publicly (professional repairers extra; Ecodesign)**
6. Provide free, clear and easily accessible information on their repair services;
7. **Not use contractual, hardware, software or other reasons, such as previous repairs by another party, as obstacles to the repair without a legitimate and objective justification.**
8. **No Refusal of Repair Due to Previous Independent Repair**
9. Optional though stimulated:
 - Provide Loan Devices
 - Use European Repair Information Form (ERIF)
