

ADDITIONAL LEVELS

Tutor Criteria: **Asbestos Awareness**



Tutors must have a minimum of at least three years' experience (within the past five years) in the health and safety sector or at least three years' experience (within the past five years) in the asbestos industry which may include, surveying, analytical, removal, consultancy, training, management etc.



Be able to demonstrate experience of delivering Asbestos Awareness Training.



Hold a suitable asbestos qualification recognised by the asbestos industry, which may include: asbestos surveying, asbestos management or asbestos removal, or other such qualifications that UKATA deems to be acceptable.



Hold a recognised trainer qualification, i.e., Level 3 Award in Education and Training, or you must achieve this qualification within 12 months of registration with UKATA.



A successful UKATA Audit, or an internal Audit undertaken by the Member company they are working for at the highest category of training the Tutor will deliver on behalf of the Member.



After meeting the above criteria, the Tutor is required to pass the UKATA Asbestos Awareness Tutor Knowledge Test.

Tutor Criteria: **Non-Licensed**

Tutor Criteria: **Licensed**



Tutors must have a minimum of at least three years' experience (within the past five years) in the asbestos industry. This will be taken to include, surveying, analytical, removal, consultancy, training, management etc. and must be able to demonstrate a comprehensive practical working knowledge, within the asbestos industry, including its legislative requirements.



A good understanding of HSE Guidance: HSG247 and be able to demonstrate experience of delivering Licensable Training.



Application

Complete the Membership and Tutor Application Forms and pay the application fees. A dedicated File Handler will be assigned to check your application, ensuring it meets UKATA's criteria, and will be your point of contact throughout.

2

Verification

Your training materials will undergo a detailed verification process. We provide a comprehensive report evaluating your materials against the relevant syllabus and will confirm if they meet the required standards or if further work is needed. Our team will work closely with you to ensure the materials are ready before proceeding to the audit.

3

Auditor Visit

Once verification is complete, an independent UKATA Auditor will attend your site to assess the tutor delivering the training. In some cases, this assessment can be conducted remotely. The Auditor will then submit a detailed report to the membership panel for evaluation.

4

Membership

The result of your application will be communicated to you. Upon approval, you will need to pay the membership fee to finalise your membership and gain access to all UKATA benefits.

Application Costs & Annual Membership Fees

Step 1: Application Fees

- Application Review & Verification of Training Materials: £250 + VAT
- Audit Fee: £500 + VAT (same for all levels)
- Tutor Registration Fee: £60 + VAT per tutor (you only need to register one tutor for the application).
Each tutor must re-register every three years at the same rate.

Step 2: Membership Fees (Payable After Approval)

- Asbestos Awareness Membership: £250 + VAT
- Non-Licensed Asbestos Work Membership: £500 + VAT
- Licensed Asbestos Work Membership: £1,000 + VAT

Ongoing Fees for Members

Licensed Members:

- Audited every year. Members will always pay both the membership fee and the audit fee each year.

Non-Licensed Members & Asbestos Awareness Members:

- Audited annually for the first two years, then every other year.
- In audit years, members pay both the membership fee and the audit fee.
- In non-audit years, members only pay the membership fee.
