SHW Live London steps up to Excel London for 2027 in next phase of growth

London, 18 June 2026 – Safety, Health & Wellbeing Live London has announced that its London event will move to Excel London for its sixth edition, taking place on 22-23 June 2027, marking a significant milestone in the continued growth of the show.

Since its launch in 2022, the southern edition of SHW Live has gone from strength to strength. From its first three editions at Farnborough International to its move to Olympia London, the event has evolved alongside the health and safety community it serves growing in both scale and impact year on year.

As the event looks ahead to 2027, the move to Excel London represents a strategic step forward, designed to take SHW Live London to the next level and deliver even greater value for exhibitors, visitors, speakers and partners.

While the venue is changing, SHW Live's London core mission remains unchanged: to deliver a high-quality regional event that brings together the health and safety community to share knowledge, discover innovation and build valuable connections.

A key part of the move is SHW Live London will co-locate with Public Protection Week (PPW), a powerful new platform uniting emergency services, security, forensics and resilience under one roof. This unlocks direct access to a broader audience of senior decision-makers responsible for protecting people, workplaces and infrastructure. For exhibitors, it means new routes to market and thousands of additional high-value connections. For visitors and partners, it creates a more connected environment for collaboration, insight and real-world problem solving.

Every venue SHW Live has called home has played an important role in its journey. The organisers extend their thanks to both Farnborough International and Olympia London for their contribution to the event's growth and success.
